- 4. To ensure that safeguarding training and other relevant developmental supports are available at both local and Province levels.
- 5. To ensure the completion of an annual audit & to make recommendations for improved practices, as appropriate.
- 6. To contribute to each NBSCCCI Review and the Province's subsequent responses to recommended future developments.
- 7. To ensure that safeguarding files, including training & vetting records, are maintained and updated.
- 8. To ensure the assessment of training and human resource needs across all safeguarding roles and to make recommendations, as appropriate.
- 9. To participate in relevant external support networks and training.
