Getting In & Around Manchester

Manchester Airport

Manchester Airport is a major UK hub with direct international flights from the US, UAE, Qatar, Germany, France, the Netherlands, China, Canada, Egypt, Turkey, Singapore, and more. If direct flights are unavailable, Liverpool and Leeds airports are just an hour away by train and offer excellent European connections.

Flying into London? You can take a connecting domestic flight to Manchester or travel by train from London Euston to Manchester Piccadilly.

From Manchester Airport to the City Centre


- Train: Direct services to Manchester Piccadilly via Northern, TransPennine Express, or Transport for Wales. Journey time: approx. 20 minutes. Cost: £3–£10.
- Tram: The Blue Line runs from the airport to city centre stops including Victoria and St Peter's Square. To reach the conference venue, transfer at St Peter's Square to a Light Blue Line tram towards Ashton-under-Lyne, Etihad Campus, or Piccadilly. Journey time: approx. 52 minutes. Cost: £4.60.
- Taxi: Approx. 30 minutes to the city centre. Cost: £30–£40. Taxis (Street Cars) are available at each terminal, with typical wait times of 10 minutes. Uber and other services can also be booked but are not permitted to wait at the terminal.

Transport within Manchester

- Walking: Manchester is a compact, walkable city.
- Tram: The Metrolink tram network connects the airport, all major train stations, and the city centre. Touch in and out using the same card or device to benefit from capped fares (daily max: £9.50). Monitors regularly check for valid tickets.
- Buse: A network of buses connects key locations, and there is a free city centre bus service (see map below).
- Taxis and Ride-hailing: Available via Street Cars, Uber, and Bolt.

Travelling from London to Manchester

- Train: Frequent direct trains from London Euston to Manchester Piccadilly run approx. every 30 minutes. Journey time: 2h 15m to 3h 30m.
- Flight: British Airways operates around 8 daily flights from London Heathrow to Manchester. Flight time: approx. 1 hour.
