3 Year Old Program

Religion: Children Learn How to Live the Gospel Message in Their Daily Lives

Literacy: Nursery Rhymes, Alphabet, Association of Letters with Sounds, Listening and Speaking

Math: Recognize Numbers, Count to 10, Identify Shapes(circles, squares, triangles), Sorting According to Shapes and Sizes, Spatial Relationships and Problem Solving

Music: Improves Listening Skills, Learn Rules and Manners through Song, Singing and Rhythmic Body Movements, Finger Plays, Play Simple Instruments



Art: Recognize Colors, Develop Eye-Hand Coordination, Learn to Use Scissors and Cut Paper, Trace Large Simple Shapes, Use of Play Dough, Use of Finger Paint

Physical Development: Playground Equipment, Climbing, Sliding, Swinging, Running, Hopping and Jumping to Develop Large Muscle Groups, Outdoor Games that Teach Cooperation, Practice Throwing, Catching and Kicking Balls

Religion: Children Explore Gospel Themes

Literacy/Language: Alphabet, Expressing Ideas, Speaking Clearly, Speaking in complete Sentences,

Math: Number Concepts, Basic Shapes, Counting, Problem Solving, Estimating, Sequencing

Music: Singing and Moving to Music, Following Directions from Songs, Rhythmic Clapping

Art: Crafts and Painting

Motor Skills: Fine: Control with Crayons, Markers and Paint, Use of Glue, Paint and Scissors, Writing with a Pencil **Gross:** Jumping, running, Skipping, Hopping, Climbing, Catching and Throwing

Social Skills: Working and Playing with Others, Self Control, Respecting Property of Others, Recognizing and Accepting Responsibility

Pre-Kindergarten Program

Religion: Children Learn Jesus' Teachings to Love God and Love Others

Literacy/Language: Different Forms and Purposes of Print, Expanded Vocabulary in Context, Pre-Writing Skills

Math: Tracing and Copying Basic Shapes, Display Numbers with Manipulatives, identify and Reproduce Patterns, Problem Solving, Measure Objects

Music: Rhymes, Songs, Marches, and Clapping to Music

Art: 8 Basic Colors, Crafts, Variety of Art Media and Materials

Motor Skills: Gross: Leaping, Skipping, Crawling, Stretching, Bending, Bouncing and Shooting Basketballs, Pouring, Dressing and Undressing
