

Poinsettia and Lattice

The Poinsettia and Lattice was produced by Northwood, it is found in three footed ruffled bowls between 8 and 9 inches in diameter, it is sometimes referred to as “Poinsettia”. The pattern on the bowl consist of the Poinsettia flowers and leaves on a lattice work. There are 4 concentric circles that ae around the lattice and flowers, and stippling can be found between the lattice work. I feel this is an under rated pattern you do not see the Poinsettia and lattice in auction as much as you would see other patterns such as the Rose and Poppy Show. The hardest to find color for the Poinsettia would be in the following order Aqua Opalescent, White, Horehound, Ice Blue and Purple followed by Marigold and Blue.

www.ddoty.com reports that an Ice Green bowl was sold in 2017, although I have not been able to find any pictures to confirm its existence.
