Wave Charging and Remissions Policy

Charges to parents

Admissions

There is no charge for admissions.

School meals

There is no charge for school meals.

Activities that take place during school hours

The Academy may on occasion ask parents/carers for a small voluntary donation towards the cost of trips/activities that take place during school hours.

Damage to property and breakages

Where school property has been wilfully damaged by a student *or parent* the school may charge those responsible for some or all of the cost of repair or replacement.

Where property belonging to a third party has been damaged by a pupil, and the school has been charged, the school may charge some or all of the cost to those responsible.

Whether or not these charges will be made will be decided by the Principal and dependent on the situation.

Charges to schools and/or Local authority

Community & Hospital Education Services

CHES will continue to charge 80% of the AWPU. Direct referrals are charged at £45 per week per student/£55 for SEN. Any students with top-up funding will be charged for proportionately. Year 11 students will be charged up to their official school leaving date in the third term. Cornwall Council will be charged for any non-state funded school referrals due to sickness as well as any EHE returners.

From September 2017, CHES will invoice schools for pupil premium & pupil premium plus. For any student with an EHC Plan where there is top up funding, it will be claimed from the main registered school.

Arrangements for Year 10 buy-ins are in place and charged at £45 per subject per week.

Permanent Exclusions

There is no charge for permanent exclusions. However, the Academy reserves the right to review this if there is an inundation of this type of referral

Special Commissions

The Academy may at any time agree special arrangements for places with local schools and/or the Local Authority. The charges that apply will be agreed between parties.

Charges

From September 2018, Academies will charge schools £500 per term (£7.69 per day) plus the SEN top-up funding at £8.20 (rate subject to CC SEN team change.) This includes Inset days.

Year 11 students will be charged up to their official school leaving date in the third term, which is the last Friday in June. Year 11s will also be the subject of a £250 charge to cover exam entry and additional transport during this time and Year 6 SATs costs at £250.

CIC Pupil premium

This will continue to be paid by the CICES team direct to the APA for singly registered pupils. Bids need to be made for the remaining 50% of the funding through the EPEP and copied to the central team for tracking.

On-Line Hub

Charges for this activity are based on £15 per subject per day for direct school referrals.

Review

This policy will be reviewed on an annual basis (or sooner if required due to unforeseen circumstances ie changes to top-up funding)
