

## Y7 literacy numeracy catch-up grant

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Using the Year 7 Literacy & Numeracy Catch-up Grant at Wave

### **What is the Year 7 Literacy & Numeracy Catch-up Grant?**

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading and/or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2).

In 2016 to 2017 schools were allocated the same overall amount of year 7 catch-up premium funding they received in 2015 to 2016, adjusted to reflect the percentage change in the size of their year 7 cohort, based on the October 2016 census.

### **Principles**

We assess the individual needs of each of the pupils who attract the year 7 catch-up premium to decide the best way to use the funding. We only select programmes and approaches that we know are effective and these are tailored to the pupils' needs.

For example, we may fund:

- individual tuition
- intensive small-group tuition
- external services and materials

Parents are informed if their child is eligible for this funding.

### **Reporting**

In 2016/17 Caradon AP Academy received £85.

In 2015/16 The Academy did not receive any of this type of funding

In 2016/17 We have used these funds to partially cover 1:1 tuition.
