

Acorn Academy Cornwall name change to Wave Multi Academy Trust Frequently Asked Questions

What is changing?

We are changing our name to Wave Multi Academy Trust. You will notice that we have a new logo, which you will see on letters and newsletters that you receive from us.

Our website address is changing to www.wavemat.org

Why are you changing the name?

We have previously been a sponsored Academy, sponsored by Acorn Care & Education Ltd. This has worked very well, but has now ended, hence the name change.

How will this change affect me, and do I need to do anything?

The change will not affect you or your child, and so you do not need to do anything different. We will continue to provide support to you in the same way as we do currently.

Transport to and from school will continue to be arranged in the same way, and we will still provide lunch in the same way.

How will I contact you now?

Our email addresses are changing – if you would like the email address for anybody in the APA, please contact them and they will be happy to pass this information on to you. All old emails will work for a short while.

Telephone numbers will remain the same.

Will the uniform change?

Yes, the uniform is changing and will have our new logo on it. We will not be charging you for the new sweatshirts.

We would be grateful if you could please return all sweatshirts with the old green Acorn Academy Cornwall logo to your child's APA.

What will the individual APAs be called?

The name of the individual APAs will not be changing.

Will it change what goes on my son/daughter's school records?

No, the information that we record on school records will not change.

Will there be any changes to my child's educational package?

There will be no changes to your child's package as a result of our change of name.

Why bother then?

We have now become an approved academy sponsor and the name change goes alongside that. This is in recognition of the high quality education we offer as a Multi Academy Trust, and we may look to bring other schools into the MAT to enable us to provide an even better education to more children across the South West.
