- Promoting The FA's RESPECT Programme and helping to develop best practice processes;
- Willingness to attend in-service training facilitated by either The FA or the local County FA;
- The commitment and ability to abide by The FA Rules and Regulations and promote The FAs Respect programme and safeguarding children education programme;
- Attendance at monthly club meetings, reporting on safeguarding issues.
