Sections:

Who Must Comply?

All California employers, except those already covered under Cal/OSHA's healthcare-specific violence standards.

• Core Requirements:

- Written WVPP for each worksite
- o Employee participation in hazard assessment & prevention
- o Training at hire and annually thereafter
- o Incident log & recordkeeping
- Annual plan review

Penalties for Non-Compliance:

- Cal/OSHA citations and fines
- o Increased liability in workplace injury cases
- Risk of lawsuits or reputational harm
