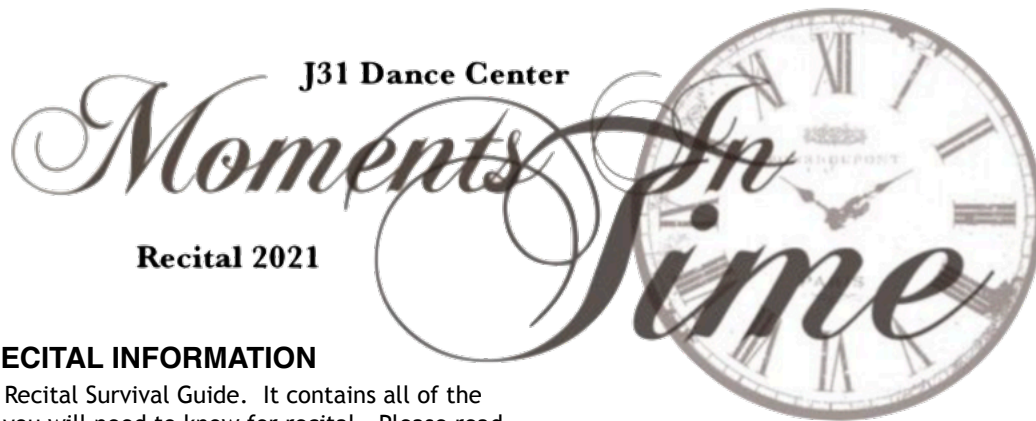


2021 Recital Survival Guide



RECITAL INFORMATION

This is your 2021 Recital Survival Guide. It contains all of the information that you will need to know for recital. Please read through the material carefully, THERE IS A LOT OF IMPORTANT INFORMATION ATTACHED. If you have questions, please contact the studio or ask your child's teacher.

LIGHTS! - Let's get ready for Recital!

Costume Distribution- costumes will be distributed on Saturday, February 13th from 1-3. Costumes will only be handed out to students who have paid in full and have paid their Recital Fee. Students will be asked to try costumes on once they get home to ensure proper fit. Costumes that do not fit need to be brought to the studios attentions ASAP in order to allow time for return/reordering.

Recital Tickets- your recital fee includes 2 tickets. Additional tickets may be purchased for \$12 each beginning June 1st. We are not sure if tickets will be available for purchase at the door for \$15, but will let you know as soon as possible. Due to COVID polices, we are currently selling a limited number of tickets, get yours early!

Recital Pictures- We will be taking individual and class photos on May 19th/20th (see picture schedule attached). Individual pictures will only be taken of dancers who pre-order them. There is no obligation to purchase pictures but all students should plan on attending their class photo time.

Extra! Extra!

Shout outs- Due June 1st- Let your favorite dancer know how proud of them you are by purchasing a Recital Shout out in our "Moments in Time" program. (see attached Shout out order form)

Recital Video- There will be no video or photography allowed during the recital. We will have a recital video available for purchase. The video will be put on a DVD. Order forms will be available on the parent portal or at the front desk beginning in May. Orders and payment will be due by June 11th.

CAMERA! - It's almost show time!

In-Studio Rehearsal- During the week of June 14th-19th, we will be having dress rehearsal during your child's regularly scheduled class time. They should arrive **IN** costume, with hair and makeup done (your child's teacher will let you know how students hair should be styled). This time will be used to finalize anything needed to be ready for the show. Please plan on attending this rehearsal with your child to make sure you hear everything you need to know for the recital.

Hair & Make Up- Please apply make-up to your child, at your discretion. For younger children, a small amount of brown eyeshadow, a little pink blush, and some pink-red lipstick will help accentuate their beautiful facial features. For older children, eyeliner and mascara are recommended as well. Make-up should be slightly exaggerated to be seen from the audience under stage lights. If in doubt about a particular color or product, please ask your child's teacher for guidance. Your child's teacher will inform each class on how to wear their hair. Please make sure all hair accessories are securely pinned to your dancer's head.

Shoes & Tights- Your child will receive a pair of tights with their costume. These are the tights that they are expected to wear to both pictures and recital. Your child's teacher will let you know what shoes will be needed. All dancers must have the appropriate shoes for each dance in order to participate.

ACTION! - Recital weekend is here!

On-Stage Dress Rehearsal- On-Stage Dress Rehearsal will be held at **Liberty Performing Arts Center the morning of the 20th**. Dancers should be **dressed in costume, ready to perform at least 15 minutes prior to their assigned time**. Make-up and proper hair style is recommended but not required for this rehearsal.

Upon arrival for dress-rehearsal, please go directly to the auditorium to await your dance. Only dancers that have quick changes (fewer than 2 dances in between their numbers) will be utilizing the dressing rooms during rehearsal. Students will be lined up backstage by a staff member, three (3) dances prior to their own dance. When they have finished their on-stage rehearsal, dancers will be returned to the auditorium to watch the remainder of the rehearsal. **ALL** students will participate in the final bow at the end of the show. **Parents must remain in the building during their child's rehearsal and are encouraged to watch from the auditorium.** This is a great opportunity to videotape and photograph your dancers since this is not permitted during the actual recital!

NO FOOD OR DRINK IS ALLOWED IN THE AUDITORIUM.

Showtime Arrival- Dancers should arrive 30 minutes prior to the start of the show. **We are unable to hold the show for children who are not ready on time.** Children should be dropped off in their assigned dressing room, ready to dance, with all their costume(s), accessories and shoes.

Dressing Rooms- Multiple dressing rooms will be used during the recital. Dancers will be dropped off to their assigned dressing room in **costume, hair/makeup done, with all accessories. Absolutely no children will be dismissed from the dressing room without their parent or guardian.** Dressing room assignments will be given at In-Studio Rehearsal the week of recital.

Finale- At the end of recital, we like to invite all dancers who participated in the show back onto the stage for one final bow. Children still in the dressing rooms at the end of the show will be escorted to the stage by a J31 staff member. After our final bow, the children will be taken back to the dressing room. Children will not be allowed to leave the dressing room until they have been checked out with a staff member.

Camera Policies- Pictures and videos may be taken at the **DRESS REHEARSAL ONLY**. This is for safety and enjoyment of the dancers and fellow audience members. A copy of the recital video will be available for purchase.



Picture Schedule- May 19th/20th

Your child needs to be dressed in their costume and ready for their picture time 10 minutes prior to the group picture time listed! **We will not be able to wait for late or missing dancers.** If you plan on purchasing photos, you can do so on the day of pictures; however it is recommended that you do so early. We ask that in order to keep pictures moving smoothly and in a timely manner, parents remain outside of the studio. We will make sure you kiddos look fabulous in their photos!
