RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Artists must be registered by July 5 for the event to participate in the show and awards ceremony
- 2. The artwork produced during the competition will belong to the artists. The Nanticoke Historical Society reserves the right to use images for promotional purposes.
- 3. Be mindful not to leave any materials behind at any of the sites.
- 4. Artists must provide their own materials, and work surface
- 5. Artists are responsible for bringing their own art supplies, umbrellas, seating and easels if necessary.
- Artists must depict the subject/scene listed on Page 1
- 7. Artwork for the show must be submitted inside the Cultural Centre no later than 3:20 p.m. of the event day.
- 8. All artwork for the show must have an identifying label attached on the back. Labels will be supplied at sign up.
- 9. Those aged 13 to 17 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- 10. Nanticoke Historical Society staff will place the artwork for display and jurying process.

Restroom Facilities will be provided at the Samantha Mill House

A form will be supplied to allow artwork to be to be displayed at the Samantha Mill House for approximately one month after the event.

Nanticoke Historical Society is not responsible for any artwork left on the premises after the awards ceremony.
