

# Do You Know These Students?

## The Student Who Struggles to Follow Instructions

may miss key parts of instructions, ask classmates what to do, and/or appear inattentive during explanations

## The Student Who Knows the Answer (But Can't Explain It)

may struggle to explain ideas clearly, give very short responses, and/or avoid speaking in class discussions

## The Student Who Struggles With Reading Comprehension

may read accurately but struggle to explain what was read, have difficulty answering questions about texts, and/or struggle with vocabulary

## The Student Who Struggles With Peer Interaction

may find group work challenging, misunderstand social cues, and/or struggle with conversation

## The Student Who Is Bright but Falling Behind

may appear capable but struggles to keep up, understand concepts but struggle to demonstrate knowledge, become increasingly frustrated with learning

## The Student Who Avoids Writing Tasks

may tire quickly when writing, complain that writing is hard, and/or complete very little written work

## The Student Who Becomes Easily Overwhelmed

may struggle in busy classroom environments, become frustrated during challenging tasks, and/or have difficulty maintaining attention

## The Student Who Struggles to Start Tasks

may wait for help before beginning work, appear overwhelmed by tasks, and/or need frequent prompting

## The Student Who Frequently Forgets What to Do

may forget instructions quickly, struggle with multi-step tasks, and/or frequently ask what they should be doing

## The Student With Messy or Difficult-to-Read Handwriting

may write slowly, struggle with letter formation, and/or have difficulty organising work on the page

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
