INTRODUCTION

It also covers the importance of linking RTS objectives with organisational goals, monitoring performance indicators and improving driver behaviour, fleet operations and road safety culture. Through case studies, practical exercises and real-world scenarios, participants will learn how to develop, implement and maintain an RTS Management System that enhances safety, supports regulatory compliance and strengthens operational resilience.
