#### INTRODUCTION

The amendment introduces new expectations for identifying, assessing and managing climate change-related threats that may affect information security, operational resilience and continuity of critical information assets. Participants will learn how to update ISMS documentation, incorporate climate considerations into risk assessments, strengthen supplier and infrastructure planning, and ensure readiness for certification audits.

- Analyse climate-related information security threats affecting digital and physical assets.
- Identify changes required within ISMS clauses, documentation and controls.

- Strengthen ISMS planning, operational controls and organisational resilience.
- Align business continuity, disaster recovery and supplier management with climate risks.
- Prepare documentation and evidence required for certification bodies.
- Support continuous improvement of the ISMS under climate-related conditions.
