1. Now that the snow has melted a few items that people discarded earlier this year have been discovered. Just in the first few warm days three flat screen monitors were found along the road in the Penn Forest area as the snow melted around them. They were under a rhododendron that hid them from view extremely well. Also, two broken chairs from a dining table were found in the Wild Creek area a short distance from the roadside. These were completely broken into small pieces. They probably would have been missed, but the cushions gave them away. Nothing was found to show a suspect.
2. The Pole barn now has electricity. It took a little longer than expected, but it is nice that the power is flowing. Now we can get garage door openers installed.
3. The PA Game Commission is beginning work on one of their fire lanes in the Long Pond area. For the work to be completed in a reasonable amount of time they are gaining access through one of the Authority fire lanes. The fire lane helps avoid bridge weight limits and shortens the drive time to get materials and equipment to the work site.
4. Trout season started this past weekend. No issues with any fisherman. Activity on the property is still extremely low.
5. ATV traffic is low with nothing on camera. An ATV and two dirt bikes were observed on Hysie Gap Road this past Monday. The vehicles drove south on Hysie Gap and did not enter onto Authority or State Game Lands property. Cameras in the area did not show these vehicles on Authority land.
