Motherhood: A Reflection from the Rectory Yard

The other morning, as I looked out over the backyard of the rectory, I caught a simple yet powerful scene: a mother goose slowly waddling across the grass, and right behind her, a line of her goslings, following her every step. There was something sacred about it. The little ones didn't question where she was going, they simply trusted her. They followed her, knowing they were safe, loved, and protected.

It reminded me that this Sunday we celebrate Mother's Day, a time to honor the women who have walked before us, guiding us, loving us, and sacrificing in ways we often don't even notice. Motherhood is not just a human experience, it's a divine gift that God has written into creation itself. From the geese in the yard to the mothers in our pews, the instinct to nurture and protect is a reflection of God's own heart.

God created motherhood to be a mirror of His unconditional love, a love that never gives up, always protects, always forgives, and always hopes. 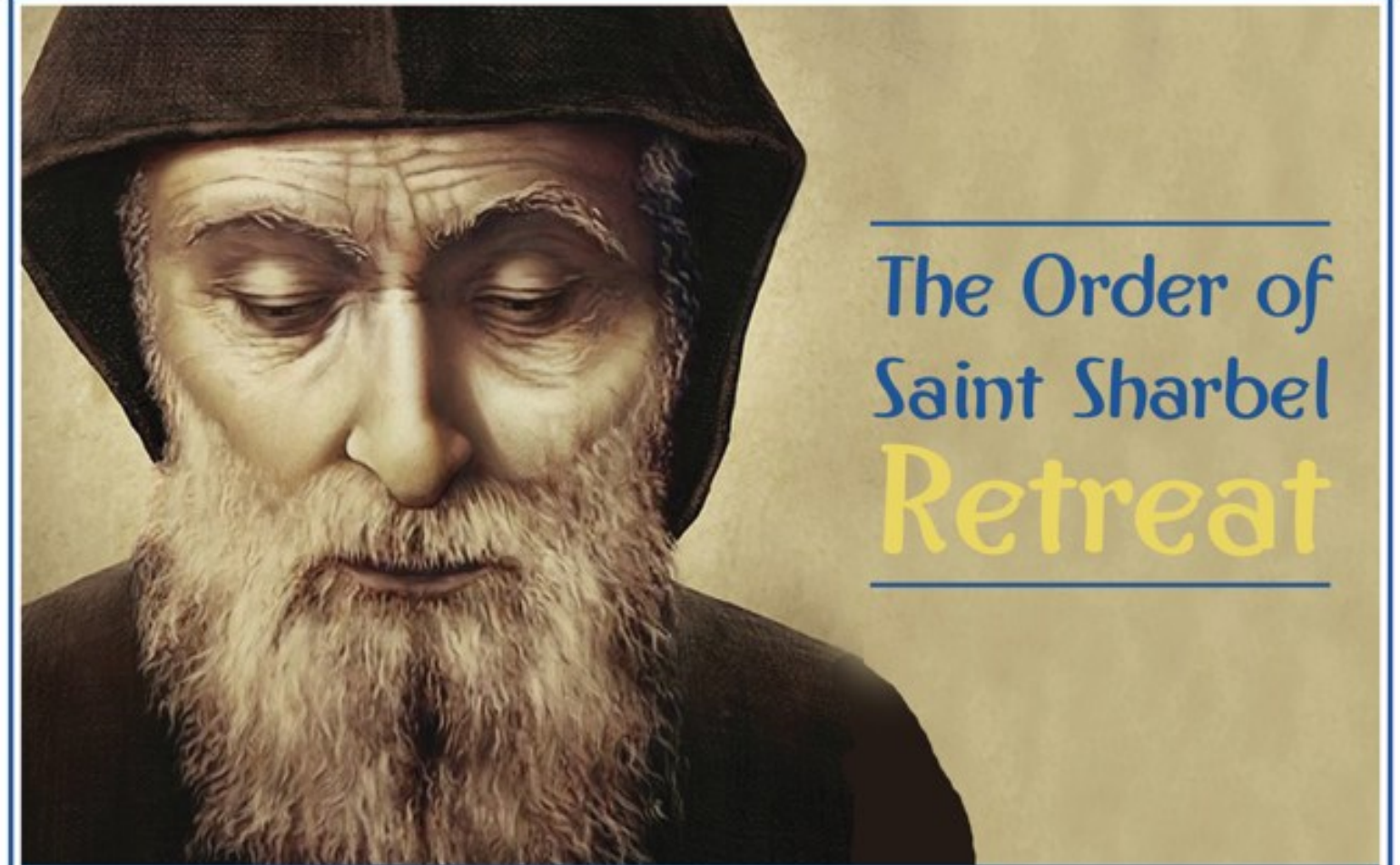

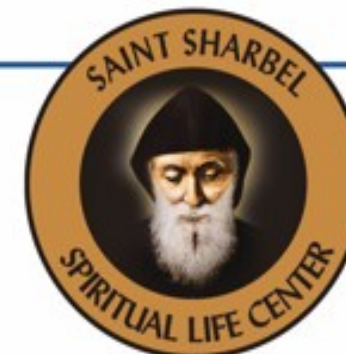
