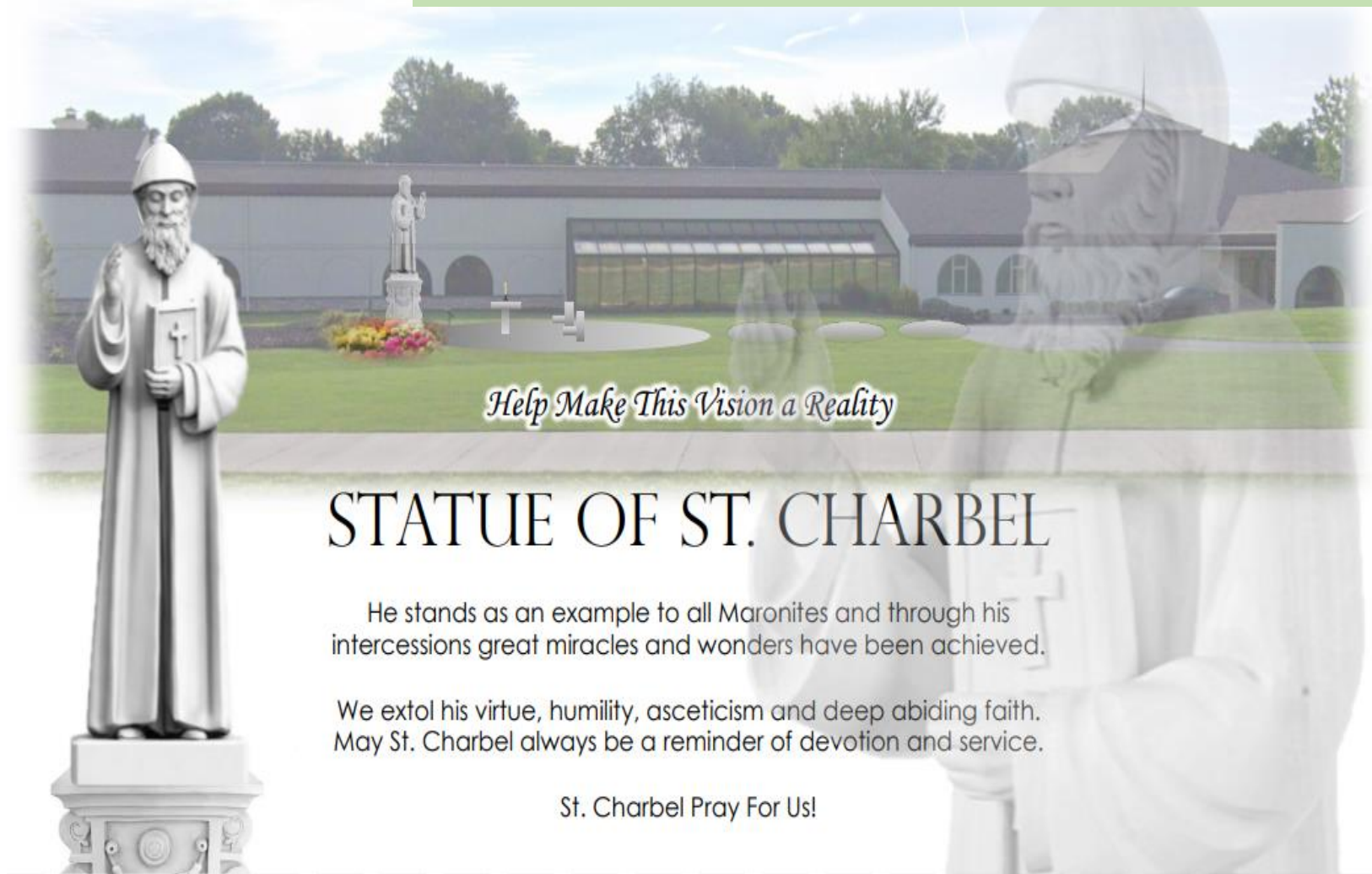

Be proud that you are Catholic

Do you know that the Catholic Church educates 2.6 million students every day at the cost of 10 billion dollars?

Do you know that the Church has 250 colleges and universities in the U.S. with an enrollment of 1 million students?

Do you know that the Catholic American Church has 637 hospitals, which account for hospital treatment of 1 out of every 5 people? There are 89 million patients who are assisted annually. They were 90 million emergency room visits and more than 100 million outpatient visits in Catholic hospitals during a one-year period. More than 5.5 million patients are admitted to hospitals annually.

Catholic hospitals employ 600,000 full-time employees and 300,000 part-time workers. There are 4,000 special centers assisting 33 million people. The church provides food services to 7 million people.
