

The efforts of our Parish and the dedication of the Ladies Guild and Men's Club are appreciated GREATLY!! Thank You and Thank You AGAIN!!




Let's Help EVERYONE receive as much from Liturgy as we can! Accessibility is a key factor in helping many people feel included in the Divine Liturgy.

EPARCHIAL NEEDS: MISSIONS, MINISTRIES AND MINISTERS

These Eparchy-supported initiatives require sound financial footing, and in some cases, capital improvements to effectively carry out the Lord's mandate to "go and make disciples." The Church demonstrates care for God's people by maintaining her presence in all Maronite parishes and missions throughout our Eparchy. Meeting the challenges that face communities in transition demands that the Church provide the resources to maintain her vibrant, vital presence. The larger church must share in this responsibility. In order that the Eparchy of Our Lady of Lebanon of Los Angeles remains strong for generations to come, we must invest in our faith today. Education, outreach, and evangelization are the primary needs described within this document and must be addressed now to ensure we have the necessary resources to shape our present and the future for our faith descendants.



HEALTHY, VIBRANT PARISHES AND MISSIONS: \$3 MILLION

One of the main priorities of the Vision for the Future – Mission for Today Capital Campaign is ensuring we have healthy, vibrant parishes – both spiritually and financially – in all our communities. Parish life is often the cornerstone of an ongoing relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ and continued growth is essential to the survival of the Maronite Church in America.

Every Maronite in our Eparchy should have equal access to the sacraments and a local parish community. We estimate that there are more than one million Maronites living in our Eparchy but sadly less than 50,000 belong to a parish. Our Eparchy covers 34 western, central and southern states yet we only have churches and missions in 18 of these states. Places like Seattle, Washington; Omaha, Nebraska; and Albuquerque, New Mexico, are eager to have their own place to gather and worship together as Maronites, yet the resources are not yet available to support these new communities.



As we celebrate our Silver Jubilee, it is Bishop Zaidan's 20/20 vision and goal to create 20 new missions over the next 20 years. Newly established Maronite communities need start up financial assistance with rent, insurance, and paying for a priest. The Eparchy is currently supporting these obligations for new locations out of operating funds, but those limited resources severely impact the rate of growth.

Additionally, there is a need to help already established churches meet existing financial obligations. To enable all our parishes to grow and thrive, a portion of the funds raised will be dedicated to providing support for all Maronite communities in our Eparchy with a significant identified need. These goals could include such initiatives as capital improvements to parish facilities, enhancing existing and/or creating new parish ministries, and reducing debt. Having a pool of funds at the Eparchy level to loan at rates significantly lower than commercial lenders, possibly even zero interest for qualifying locations, will ensure more of the funds raised locally are applied directly to parish growth and support.
