These are the promises the Sacred Heart of Jesus made to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque:

I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.

I will give peace in their families.

I will console them in all their troubles.

I will be their refuge in life and especially in death.

I will abundantly bless all their undertakings.

Sinners shall find in my Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.

Tepid souls shall become fervent.

Fervent souls shall rise speedily to great perfection

I will bless those places wherein the image of My Sacred Heart shall be exposed and venerated.

I will give to priests the power to touch the most hardened hearts.

Persons who propagate this devotion shall have their names eternally written in my Heart.

In the excess of the mercy of my Heart, I promise you that my all-powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: They will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure Refuge in that last hour.

The Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus The Ways of Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

The devotion to the sacred heart of Jesus started shortly after the apparitions of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque at Paray-Le-Monial in the convent of the Sisters of the Visitation, France. This happened in 1674, when Jesus appeared to this nun for two consecutive years. This devotion with the time took a very big public manifestation and was practiced in many different ways.

A) – The Holy Hour

On the night between the first Thursday and Friday, people would wake up at 11 o'clock and would observe one hour of prayer until midnight. They would do this Holy Hour as they call it, whether at home with the family or at church in groups. People do this Saintly practice in remembrance of the wish of Christ expressed to Margaret Mary Alacoque, in 1674, in order to make reparation for his Sacred Heart.

B) – **Communion**

People devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus would receive communion every first Friday of each month. Jesus has told St. Margret that whoever receives communion for nine consecutive First Fridays would be assured of having a peaceful and Saintly death. Many people became very faithful to the nine consecutive communions on first Fridays.

C) - Consecration of Homes to the Sacred Heart of Jesus Appearing to St. Margaret, Jesus gave her 12 famous promises.

In the ninth promise, Jesus says: "I will bless the homes where the icon of my sacred heart is exposed and honored."

D) – Consecration of Families to the Sacred Heart of Jesus This devotion spread especially among the families, who used to erect a little alter to the icon or a statue of the sacred heart, lit day and night by candles or electric lights in honor of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Pope Pius XI encouraged this family devotion, which was spread almost all over the world. E) – The Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus In 1765, Pope Pius IX, made the feast of the Sacred Heart a mandatory feast. In Lebanon, this feast is done just on the first Friday, after the Thursday Feast of the Holy Body, on the second week after Pentecost. F) – The Church of the Sacred Heart in Paris On the hill of Montmart, in Paris, there is one of the most beautiful churches consecrated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. It was erected in 1873. On the top of the front wall there is an inscription saying: "From the repentant France to the Sacred Heart of Jesus." The highest dome is 250 feet, the bell tower 300 feet, there is also a very heavy bell.

G) - The statue of the Sacred Heart in Lebanon In 1933, the Jesuits who founded in the city of Ghazir, Lebanon, the famous Maronite Seminary in 1844, erected the first statue in the Middle East consecrated to the sacred Heart of Jesus. It was installed on the top of the city, measuring 25 feet from top to bottom. The famous blessed Jacob the Capuchin built a big convent dominating the Mediterranean Sea and the Darg River in Jounieh, Lebanon and erected on the top of this great building is a big statue of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Amen
