Handling, installing, and caring for the ceramic sculpture:

Handling: The piece is heavy and the ceramic folds are fragile. When handling the piece don't put any pressure on the ceramic elements or wedge your fingers between the frame and the tiles because they could break. ONLY HANDLE THE PIECE BY THE FRAME or EDGE OF THE WOOD BACKING AND NEVER SET IT UP SIDE DOWN.

Installation: The steel frame hangs on one or two leveled brackets on the wall, preferably with the middle hole screwed into a stud. If there are no studs where you'd like to install the piece, you'll need the appropriate anchors to securely fasten the bracket. When mounting the sculpture on the wall make sure you only handle by the frame/edge and not put pressure on the ceramic folds.

Caring: If someone touches the ceramic and leaves a smudge or a mark you can erase it by lightly sanding the spot with a Superfine sanding pad or a light colored 200 - 400 grit sandpaper (not the black or red kind). To dust the piece, use a compressed air can sprayer. Don't use cleaners or a wet or damp cloth on the ceramic because it will stain it. Wipe the frame with a dry cloth or microfiber to remove dust.
