Income Documentation Checklist

You MUST have homeowners insurance to partner with Wild Rivers Habitat for Humanity.

- **OBTAIN <u>ALL</u> COPIES OF THE INCOME DOCUMENTS THAT ARE DESCRIBED IN THIS CHECKLIST THAT APPLY TO THE CURRENT SITUATION OF EACH ADULT MEMBER OF THE HOUSEHOLD.
- **PLEASE INCLUDE A \$19.00 (One Applicant) or \$30.00 (Two Applicants) CHECK FOR THE CREDIT REPORT. THE APPLICATION CAN NOT BE PROCESSED WITHOUT IT.
- ** You must be willing to partner with Wild Rivers Habitat for Humanity. An approved applicant must complete sweat equity hours (on the family's home and other projects) and these hours must be completed between selection and project completion.
- **You must include photos or email photos (<u>office@wildrivershabitat.org-</u> please indicate you have mailed an application as well) of repairs needed.

Employment Income and Other Income:

- 2 years most recent tax returns (1st 2 pages of form 1040 only)
- *Employment Income*: at least 3 consecutive months of most recent pay stubs and a letter from each employer verifying the following: 1. Date hired, 2. Number of regular hours worked a week, and 3. The wage per hour
- Other Income: any other income statements (SSI, SSDI, RSDI, Disability, VA Benefits, unemployment, alimony, child support). To request a proof of income for SSI, SSDI, RSDI please call 1-800-772-1213 or go to www.SocialSecurity.gove to obtain documentation. (Medical assistance, food stamps, and child care assistance are not considered for income qualifications and will not be needed to document)
- Rental Income: a signed agreement between the landlord and the tenant including rental dates and price

Self-Employment Income:

- 2 years most recent tax returns including all schedules
- Most recent 6 months' worth of income and expenses for your business

Unofficial Transcript:

- If a member of the household is age 18 or older and is enrolled in school full-time while receiving income, provide a copy of an unofficial school transcript.

Challenges: Some houses have issues beyond repair and must be rejected during the application process. The affiliate relays heavily on volunteers to complete projects.

The following <u>may</u> make an applicant ineligible for the Home Preservation Program:

- Overly high debt to income ratio
- Home in need of repairs not covered by Wild Rivers Habitat
- Gross household income too high or too low
- Poor credit history

Repayment Plan: Homeowners are charged for the value of materials (both purchased and donated) and sub-contracted work, plus an administrative fee.
