TRIM SIZE: 8" x 5"

This is the size of the page.

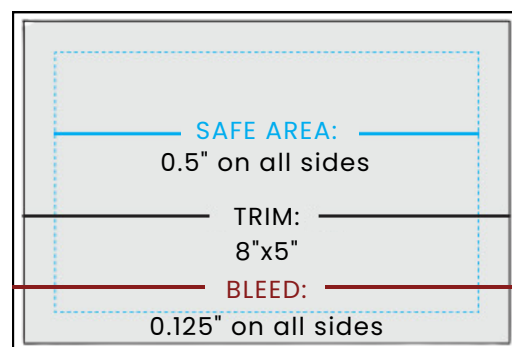
Your ad will display in the program extending to the edges with no blank space.

RECOMMENDED SAFE AREA: 0.5" ON ALL SIDES

As a recommendation, do not place anything of importance (text or logos for instance) outside of the safe area, at least 0.5" away from all sides.

BLEED SIZE: Add an extra 0.125" of art to all sides of the ad. The file size with the bleed would be 8.25" x 5.25".
