# Azadi Far Ride to the Murray



# A Mustang Story The Docuseries








The Faroe Islands, in addition to their spectacular landscapes, have sustained their own distinctive breed of horses for at least 1500 years. The history is not well known or exact, but it is believed they were imported as work horses and then left to their own devices in the wild without any human caregiving when they were not being used.

This led to the numbers of the population rising and falling over hundreds of years, finally peaking at 800 in the 1800's and subsequently plunging to a mere 5 individuals.

In the 1970s the Faroese Horse Association was formed, and action was taken by both the organization and other interested people to try to preserve these horses.
