





But Henny Chicken is having trouble. She is not able to lay any eggs in her nest.




Henny Chicken is sad. She really, really wants her very own baby chicks.




What to do?






Down the way,

Penny cannot keep her extra eggs warm, so they will not hatch and that makes Penny very sad.






Henny sits for days and days, waiting for her very own baby chicks to hatch.






Pretty soon, peck, peck, peck. Crack, crack, crack...






