

## New California Plan

As defined in Article IV, Section 3 of the US Constitution, there is only one way to create a new State:

***New States may be admitted by the Congress into this Union, but no new State shall be formed or erected within the Jurisdiction of any other State, nor any State be formed by the Junction of two or more States, or Parts of States, without the consent of the Legislatures of the States concerned as well as of the Congress.***

- The only path to a new state is through the lawful process laid out in the United States Constitution.
- There is no path to statehood through the courts.
- There is no path to statehood through referendum or election. We've been there before, and it died in committee in 1992.
- No new state has ever been brought into the Union which could not demonstrate the ability to govern itself.

## New California State Council of County Representatives (CCR)

The New California State Council of County Representatives (CCR) officially came into existence as a representative body when its Charter was ratified September 9, 2017.

## Demographic Estimates

**New California — 15 Million  
California — 25 Million**

New California will be the 6th largest state behind New York (bigger than Illinois and Pennsylvania).

It is estimated 25-27 seats in the US House of Representatives will go to New California.

Old California will become the 2nd most populous state behind Texas and ahead of Florida, losing 25-27 seats in the US House of Representatives.

The five Southern New California counties have a population of just over 11 million. If they were to break away, they would be a state the size of Ohio, probably larger as some other counties might join.

# NEW CALIFORNIA ISSUES



New California is a new state in development by egregiously aggrieved Californians exercising our Constitutional right to form a new state separate from the tyranny of the State of California.

***That, whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Government, laying its foundation on such Principles and organizing its Powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their Safety and Happiness.***

## **New California — New State, New Slate**

---

New California is a tax-exempt 501c(4) nonprofit organization in the United States, pending letter of determination from IRS and NOT incorporated in Old California!

New California will be a United States of America Constitutional State and will follow the U.S. Declaration of Independence, Constitution, and Bill of Rights.

ALL members of the New California Government (County Councils) are sworn in under the United States of America Oath to Protect and Defend the Constitution.

New California's smaller government will start with the 1878 California Constitution in which the State Legislature meets once every two years and in session for 60 days.

New California will be a Right-to-Work State and ensure the least restrictive Business and Economic Environment, the highest Education Standards, and the most Secure Living Environment of the 51 States of the Union.

From the current 343 government agencies in California, New California will have less than 150 government agencies.

No California Air Resources Board CARB.

Lower Taxes on gas, sales, and property.

Regionalism (Soviet-style governance) will be prohibited by the New California State Constitution.

No Employment Development Department EDD.

Education system will put New Californians first with a family centered K-12 system. University, College, Community College (unattached from the University of California) will be staffed with the finest teachers in the world.

New California's Adult Education system will become the largest assimilation program in the nation, offering the most English language immersion programs in the world while training and retraining those who need to develop new skills or retrain current skills necessary for economic improvement.

Students will be required to be proficient in the English Language in order to graduate from high school.

There will be NO Sanctuary State, City, or County status.

Manual Arts — Shop/Home Ec, Art, and Music — will return to public Education.

High Standard of living will return to New California with an economic explosion never seen since the 1980s.

New California will become the Number One business-friendly state in the Union.

15 Million est. population for New California increases representation.

A legal pathway to New California following the U.S. Constitution's Article IV, Section 3.

We are currently creating the New California Government with the 40 Counties shown on the New California map.

New California will have five deep-sea ports.

New California will have the best highway

transportation system in the world.

New California will be the Bread Basket of the World with the largest agricultural area found on the planet in the Central Valley.

New California will be the richest mineral deposited area of the world.

Timbering will return to Northern New California.

Respect for the Natural Resources of California will return.

The destruction of our foothills and forests from illegal growing and cultivations will stop.

Construction of new dams and water resource will begin within five years of New California statehood.

Infra-Structure maintenance will NOT be neglected.

The National Guard, Law Enforcement, and First Responders will be given the necessary skills, training, and equipment to keep New Californians SAFE.

New California Department of Motor Vehicles' fees and services will be scaled back.

- NCDMV will not be used as voter registration centers.
- New California driver's licenses and identification cards will only be issued to United States Citizens and New California Citizens. Proof of U.S. Citizenship is required.

Health Care Exchanges will not exist in New California.
