The unanimous Declaration for Separation and Independence of the Areas united within New California

When, during the normal course of human history, it becomes necessary that a group of Citizens finds it undeniable that they must completely end their relationship with an existing political group and adopt an equal, separate and sovereign status to which, based upon God's Natural Laws, all of humankind are entitled, action must be taken. Common and decent respect for humanity compels such a group of people to clearly and publicly declare their intent and reasons which have forced them to end the specific relationship in question. Such a time and situation has come for a significant portion of the people residing within the State of California.

We, the people wishing to end this relationship, hold the following truth to be obvious, undeniable, and irrevocable: that all people are created equal and have been equipped and supplied by ~~the~~ the Creator with certain rights that cannot and must not be abused or removed. These rights include life, personal freedoms, the ownership and control of property, and the right to pursue happiness.

As a means to secure these God-ordained rights, governments are created which derive their power and authority from the consent of the people they govern. It is the people who give the government permission to govern, and then willingly submit to that government's designated authority, so long as that authority shall not be abused.

However, when any Government decides to abuse or eliminate these stated rights, it is the right and responsibility of the people under said Government to change that Government; or if necessary, abolish the ties and responsibilities to the existing Government altogether. It becomes an imperative to recreate a Government which is once again founded upon the principles of freedom, and God's Laws; and organize in such a way as to guarantee those freedoms.

It is the duty of the oppressed people to remember that logic, caution and good judgement require that established Governments should not be altered hastily, without good reason or for temporary circumstances.

35 However, experience has demonstrated that people have a tendency to
36 suffer through many Government evils, rather than change them; as long
37 as the suffering is not too extreme, too slowly executed, or purposefully
38 harmful. Why? Because as people get used to things being a certain way, it
39 takes great awareness, effort, wisdom and dedication to create the positive
40 change necessary to break away from harsh Governmental abuses.

41 When a long series of abuses and thefts of freedoms have been executed
42 by the Government, designed to achieve the goal of putting the People
43 under the rule of violent tyrants, it becomes the right of the People, even
44 more, it becomes the duty of the People, to defeat and cast aside that
45 Government and create a new Government, with new safeguards to protect
46 Citizens' freedoms and liberties.

47 This is what has and is still happening to citizens within many areas of
48 California who have long been patient in this matter of suffering
49 governmental tyranny. The citizens within these consolidated counties have
50 reached a point where they have no choice but to alter the current system
51 of Government where their rights have been abused and denied.

52 The history of the current and preceding Governors and the Government of
53 California, throughout decades of neglect and mismanagement, has
54 demonstrated repeated injuries and usurpations, all having one single
55 objective: an absolute Tyranny over the Citizens within California and the
56 aggrieved Counties of the area to be known as the State of New California.
57 To prove this, consider the following facts which we make public for the
58 whole world to evaluate:

65 **Whereas:**

66 At every stage of our suffering and oppression under this existing
67 Government, we have humbly, repeatedly, officially and publicly
68 asked for the ceasing of this oppression, and the corrections of these
69 abuses. Our requests have been ignored and met only with further injury
70 and insult. The recent Governors and Governments, and the injustices they
71 have instituted as laws and regulations, with this type of character and
72 morals, can be defined in only one possible way: Tyrants, unfit to govern
73 free People.

74 The current government of California subordinates the individual to the
75 state, rather than working to address the needs of the people who hire it,
76 and tries to control all aspects of its Citizens' lives by coercive and
77 oppressive measures. Its totalitarian policies are designed to tax and
78 regulate its citizens in an unjust manner.

79 We have never failed to warn or inform our State Brethren of these perils.
80 We have warned them multiple times of attempts by their Legislature to
81 over-extend their authority over the Citizens who hire and empower them
82 with the duty to protect our common welfare. We have reminded our fellow
83 Citizens of the circumstances of our immigration and settlement here as
84 free Citizens of the United States of America, and their rights as Citizens.

85 After appealing for a sense of Justice and Goodness in our Citizens and
86 our Government, many are still deaf to the voice of Justice and the
87 relationship to our common heritage and rights.

88 **Therefore we Conclude and Declare that:**

89 The Representatives of the united Council of County
90 Representatives of New California, in General Congress, having
91 assembled and prayed to God about the honor and rightness of our
92 conclusions, publish and declare with grave seriousness by the name and
93 authority of the good people of these counties and areas the following:

94 The Citizens of these united Counties and areas within New
95 California are, and of Right ought to be, a Free, Independent and
96 Sovereign state within the United States of America.

97 We are absolved from all Allegiance to the State of California, and
98 that all political connections and control between the New California
99 state and the State of California, are and ought to be totally and
100 permanently dissolved.

101 Further, as a Separate, Free, Sovereign and Independent state, we
102 shall have the same full powers of any state in the Union to levy Law
103 and Order, conclude Peace, contract Alliances, establish Commerce,
104 and do all other Acts and Things which an Independent New
105 California state, as a Sovereign Constitutional member of the United
106 States of America, may of right do.

107 With the support of this Declaration of Separation and Independence
108 from the State of California, and a firm reliance on the protection of
109 Divine Providence, we mutually pledge to each other our Lives, our
110 Fortunes, and our Sacred Honor.
