


## Nativity Academy Receives Samtec Cares Grant



Nativity Academy at St. Boniface has been chosen as a 2024 recipient of the Samtec Cares Grant. With this grant providing nearly \$40,000 in funding, Nativity will add two Mira Laser Engraving machines to the academy's Makerspace. Additionally, we will now extend our partnership with Brainstem U for the next 5 years. This partnership will include teaching innovative STEM programming to Nativity students on these machines.

Samtec Cares states on its website that one focus of their grants is technology and innovation. With these grants they support organizations that achieve impact through creative tools and solutions, including STEM-related hands-on learning programs with real-world applications.




