Summer meals are good for students' bodies, and healthier students are great for everybody. Kids get nutritious meals at no charge at any of the JCPS Summer Meal sites. Due to changes on the federal level parents can no longer pick up meals on behalf of their child. Children must attend the sites in person and meals must be eaten on site. Children must be 18 years of age or younger to participate. (Adults are not served.)

Nutrition services will continue to provide meals throughout the Summer at **no cost** via school locations, mobile routes, and at pools, parks and enrichment sites.
