Irish tenor Seán Tester is a versatile artist whose repertoire spans from baroque to bel canto. A graduate of the Royal Irish Academy of Music, where he earned both a Master's in Music Performance (with distinction) and the Recital Artist Diploma, Seán was appointed the Academy's inaugural Emerging Artist Fellow and is a recipient of the BVOF | RIAM John Pollard Bursary. With

a natural affinity for the lirico-leggero repertoire, he made his international debut as Rodolphe in Rossini's Guillaume Tell in a co-production between Irish National Opera and Nouvel Opéra Fribourg. His stage experience includes work with Irish National Opera, Wexford Festival Opera, Blackwater Valley Opera Festival, and the Sligo Baroque Festival, alongside recital & concert appearances at the Dublin International Chamber Music Festival, Drogheda Classical Music Series, and the Franz Liszt Old Academy of Music in Budapest.
