



Tour Itinerary:

October 16, 2022, Sunday - Depart RDU - Fly to Istanbul

October 17, 2022, Monday - **Arrive Istanbul Airport** mid-afternoon. Our guide will meet us and assist through customs and formalities. Transfer by bus to the hotel. Overnight in Istanbul. (D)

October 18, 2022, Tuesday - Istanbul

Full day Istanbul tour; visit the Roman Hippodrome, the Blue Mosque, the Hagia Sophia, Then visit the Istanbul Archaeological Museum and St. Irene Church. If time permits, walk through a section of the Grand Bazaar. Overnight in Istanbul. (B,D)

October 19, 2022, Wednesday - Fly Izmir Airport - Ephesus - Kusadasi Transfer to Istanbul Airport for early morning flight to Izmir. Drive to Selcuk town for full day tour of Ephesus. View the Library, the huge Agora, and the Temple of Artemis which was declared one of the Seven Wonders of the World. We'll visit the Basilica of St. John, traditional site of his grave. Visit the Museum of Ephesus for an up-close look at artifacts from the ancient city. We will have time to explore this powerful city on your own and recreate some of the footsteps of Paul. Dinner and overnight in Kusadasi. (B,D)



October 20, 2022, Thursday - Patmos - Kusadasi

7:00 a.m. ferry to Patmos. Arrive Patmos at the Port of Skala at 11:30 am. Visit the **Cave of the Apocalypse** and the **Monastery of St. John the Theologian**. If time permits, walk down the path to Skala and visit the baptismal font where John baptized the first Christian converts on the island. Return to Kusadasi at 19:30. Dinner and overnight in Kusadasi. (B,D)

October 21, 2022, Friday – Laodicea, Hierapolis - Overnight Pamukkale Drive east to Pamukkale area (3 hours). Visit Laodicea. Although the excavation work is still in its early stages, Laodicea was a major city in Roman times. After lunch break, visit Hierapolis and Pamukkale and the white calcified cliffs and later the impressive amphitheater. We will visit the Martyrium of St. Philip. We'll see the Gate of Domitian, column-lined streets and arches that have stood through time and earthquake. Overnight in Pamukkale. (B.D)

October 22, 2022, Saturday - Philadelphia - Sardis - Smyrna (Izmir) - Izmir Visit Philadelphia and the Church of St. John the Theologian. Travel to Sardis and tour the city including the massive scale of the Temple of Artemis and by the white marble Royal Road, the gymnasium and the synagogue. Continue to Izmir. Drive up to Mt. Pagus (now called Kadifekale or "Velvet Castle"). Visit the location of the Smyrna Theater, the Smyrna Stadium where St. Policarp was martyred. Then, we will visit the Smyrna Agora, see its latest excavations including the Grafitti Section which is closed to public. Dinner and overnight in Izmir. (B,D)

October 23, 2022, Sunday - Thyatira, Pergamum, Troas - Overnight Canakkale Drive to Akhisar to see the Thyatira Church remaining. Continue to Pergamon where we will visit the Acropolis with the steepest theater of the ancient world and the Temple of Trajan. We will also visit the Red Basilica which was an Egyptian Temple, later converted to a church. Visit the Alexandrian Troas, important port founded by Alexander the Great. Paul visited here at least twice. Dinner and overnight in Canakkale. (B,D)

October 24, 2022, Monday - Troy - to Greece Border - Kavala Proceed to Troy to see the legendary city of Homer's Iliad. Cross the Dardanelles Strait by car ferry. Drive the border into Greece and transfer to our Greek bus and guide, and continue to Kavala for overnight. (B,D)

October 25, 2022, Tuesday - Neapolis, Philippi, and Amphipolis - Overnight Thessaloniki

Visit Neapolis (Kavala), one of Greece's most picturesque mainland ports. Travel inland 10 miles to Philippi. Visit the place where Paul converted Lydia and see a crypt dating from the Roman period, which is thought to have served as a prison for the apostle Paul. See the famous Acropolis, the Market Place, the Basilica, and the Theater. Travel to Amphipolis, where you will see the ruins of many Christian basilicas. Pass through Apollonia like the apostle Paul and Silas. Dinner and overnight in the Thessaloniki area. (B,D)

October 26, 2022, Wednesday - Thessaloniki and Veria - Overnight Meteora (Kalambaka)

In Thessaloniki, visit St. George's Basilica, where tradition holds it is built over the synagogue where Paul preached. View the Old City Ramparts, and the Galerius Arch that rises over the Via Egnatia. Visit the Archaeological Museum. See two of the most beautiful basilicas in the city, St. Sophia and St. Demetrios, dedicated to a distinguished member of the Roman army and a martyred Christian convert. Continue on to Meteora for dinner and overnight. (B,D)



October 27, 2022, Thursday - Meteora and Delphi - Overnight Athens

Visit the rock forest of Meteora in western Thessaly and ponder the rough terrain in which the apostle Paul walked during his missionary journey. See famous Byzantine monasteries perch precariously on summits of soaring, sheer-sided grey rock pinnacles of varied and spectacular shapes. Visit one of these monasteries. Travel to scenic and historic Delphi, the religious center of the ancient Greek world, considered by early Greeks to be the center of the world and marked by the conical stone, called the omphalos or navel. Walk the Sacra Via to the Athenian Treasury, the Theatre, and the Temple of Apollo where the oracle performed his or her prophetic rituals. Visit the Museum where we will view many ancient treasures, the chief of which is the 5th century bronzed Charioteer. Dinner and overnight in Athens. (B,D)

October 28, 2022, Friday - Athens

Enjoy the architectural splendors of the ancient city of Athens as you follow our guide to the world renowned Acropolis, the Propylaea, the Parthenon, and the Erectheum. View Mars Hill where the apostle Paul stood and addressed the Athenians. See the Agora, the ancient market place and center of the Athenian public life, where the apostle Paul preached to the skeptical Athenians. Journey to Sounion to visit the famous Temple of Poseidon. Overnight in Athens. (B,D)

October 29, 2022, Saturday - Athens

Take a cable car to the top of Mount Lycabettus. Tour the House of Parliament, the Presidential Palace and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Free time to walk through Plaka or the Varvakeios Central Market or enjoy an afternoon to relax. (B,D)

October 30, 2022, Sunday - Corinth, Cenchrea, and Eleusis


In Corinth, see the ancient city where Paul met Aquila and Priscilla, the tent makers, and where the apostle spent eighteen months sharing the Gospel. Visit the Archaeological Museum, the Market Place and Temples. Walk among the ruins and stand on the Bema where Paul stood before Gallio facing charges brought by the Jews. Visit the ancient port of Cenchrea where Paul departed when he returned to Syria. Visit the Archaeological Museum, the Market Place and Temples. Walk among the ruins and stand on the Bema where Paul stood before Gallio facing charges brought by the Jews that were dropped. Paul stayed awhile in Corinth before leaving for Syria from the port at Cenchraeae. Later we will visit the site of Eleusis where the sacred rites of the Eleusinian Mysteries were performed. Overnight in Athens. (B,D)

October 31, 2022 Monday - Athens - Burlington

Depart early in the morning for our flight back to RDU. Arrive late that day.
