To our incredible supporters,

As we wrap up our 50th year serving youth in our community, we find ourselves both reflecting with gratitude and looking ahead with purpose. Thank you for believing in the power of mentoring and in the potential of young people across our region. Your generosity fuels more than programs, it fuels relationships, stability, and hope.

This past year alone, together we served **399** young people through one-to-one mentoring relationships that continue to deliver meaningful, measurable impact. **87% of youth demonstrated educational success**, **94% were less likely to engage in risky behaviors**, and **75% showed improved social-emotional competency**. Even more telling, **95% of our matches reported a positive match experience**, reinforcing the strength and quality of the relationships you help make possible.

We are also proud to share that the strength of our mission is reflected not only in outcomes—but in our culture. In the most recent Coolest Place to Work survey across the Corridor, Big Brothers Big Sisters earned an average score of **5.68 out of 6**. That recognition is a powerful testament to the dedicated, passionate team your support helps sustain.

While we celebrate this milestone year, our work is far from done. **The Empowering Potential Campaign**, launched during our 50th anniversary, will continue for the next four years, ensuring Big Brothers Big Sisters is positioned to serve youth for decades to come. Your continued investment helps strengthen programs today while building long-term sustainability for the future.

Thank you for being part of our first 50 years, and for helping shape the next 50. Together, we are changing lives, one relationship at a time.

SHELBY & JACION — BUILDING CONNECTION BEYOND THE LUNCH TABLE

Shelby is a Lunch Buddy matched with her Little, Jacion, and her impact reaches far beyond their time together at school. In addition to regular school visits, Shelby has intentionally built a strong, supportive relationship with Jacion's mom. They communicate often, coordinate school visits together, and occasionally connect outside of school with mom present—strengthening trust and consistency for Jacion.

This partnership has helped address a significant barrier Jacion previously faced: school attendance. By working together, Shelby and Jacion's mom have created a stronger circle of support around him—one that helps him show up more regularly and feel more connected.

As Shelby shared, “being a Lunch Buddy [is] whatever you make it like.” While she recognizes “there is nothing wrong with the minimum,” Shelby chose to invest more deeply. By getting to know Jacion’s mom and checking in regularly—sometimes receiving “a picture of what they did on the weekend”—Shelby has become “more of a part of his life rather than just... this random person that comes to see him at school twice a month for a short time.”

Because of supporters like you, mentors are able to go beyond the lunch table—building meaningful relationships that strengthen families, improve attendance, and help young people like Jacion thrive.
