Pikes Peak #143 NFL 35 Pool- 2025

In the NFL 35 pool format, members are each assigned a unique NFL team (32 members max). Members win when their team scores 35 points.

A team ended the 2021 NFL regular seasons with a score of 35 a total of 5 times. This is an excellent format for the more casual user, who are looking for some excitement during the NFL season without having to research picks or rush to get their picks in before a deadline.

The cost is \$100 for the entire NFL regular season which consists of 17 games/weeks. Each member is randomly assigned different NFL teams each week. With each receiving exactly one bye based on the NFL schedule of the first week's NFL team assignment. Participation is first come, first serve basis.

NFL team assignments will be every Tuesday, starting at 6:15. You have until 7:00 before you are marked absent. If you are not present for a drawing when you're called, another member will substitute for you. You are allowed 3 absences before you are dropped from the roster. You are also allowed to miss the week your team has a bye.

Winners are declared only when their team scores exactly 35 points. If no team scores 35 points during a week, the pool will roll over to the following week. When someone finally hits 35 points, they are considered the winner of that week, and all consecutive weeks prior that did NOT have a winner. The cash prize each week will be \$100. In the event that there is no winner the 17th week that cash prize will be rolled into football squares for the Super Bowl. Each player will select 3 squares.
