REMINDER

- Supervision is **NOT** provided before 9:00 am. BGCB is not responsible for any members before opening time. Please note that members who drop off before programming times are at risk and are the parent/guardian's responsibility.

AGE REQUIREMENTS

Members must be minimum 5 years old and maximum 17 years old. Four-year-olds must meet requirements to attend:

- One year of pre-school completed
- Potty-trained
- Will be attending Kindergarten in the 2026-2027 School Year

TRANSPORTATION

- The Naco Bus Route will have no capacity limit, but the Bisbee Van Route will have a limit due to low demand for Bisbee Pick-Up/Drop-Off. **Call to sign up for Bisbee Van!** Transportation routes will be completed and posted by June 1st.
- Please have your child(ren) at the bus stop/pick-up location 10 minutes before the scheduled time.
- Bus stops will be dropped from the route after the first week if no child is present at the specific stop.
- Transportation privileges can be revoked if the member(s) can not follow bus/van rules. **Disruptive behavior will NOT be tolerated.**

- The Boys & Girls Club of Bisbee will host TOOTH BUDDS, a non-profit that provides FREE
 - Dental Screenings
 - Cleanings
 - Fluoride
 - Sealants
 - Silver Diamine Fluoride (stops active decay)
 - S.M.A.R.T. Restorations (similar to getting a fill, but without a needle or drill)
- The services will be available from July 6th until July 10th during our Club hours of 9 am to 3 pm.
- Members AND non-members will be able to receive services as long as a consent form is signed.
