*ADULT/YOUTH (IN THIS CATEGORY THE "ADULT" MUST BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD AND OUT OF HIGH SCHOOL)

RULES

- BOWLERS MUST BOWL IN A JUNIOR LEAGUE IN THE HOUSE THEY REPRESENT, BE AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF THAT LEAGUE AND COMPLETE A MINIMUM OF 2/3 THE SEASON.
- ALL YOUTH TOURNAMENTS WILL BE ADMINISTERED BY THE HOST CENTER AND WILL BE OFFICIATED BY M.S.C.B.A. CERTIFIED REFEREES.
- A JUNIOR BOWLER WHO PARTICIPATES IN ANY JUNIOR EVENT DURING THE YEAR WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ADULT EVENTS IN THAT SAME YEAR.
- ALL BOWLERS ARE ALLOWED TO MOVE TO A HIGHER AGE BRACKET FOR ANY DOUBLE, TRIPLE OR TEAM EVENT. THIS MUST BE DECLARED AT THE TIME OF ENTRY.
- HOST CENTER WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PUTTING BOWLERS WITHOUT A FULL TEAM TOGETHER WITH OTHER BOWLERS FROM OTHER CENTERS.
- PROPER DRESS CODE - ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST WEAR A BOWLING SHIRT WITH THE NAME OF THE HOUSE OR HOUSE LOGO THEY'RE REPRESENTING. ALL CLOTHING MUST BE NEAT AND PRESENTABLE. NO HATS/CAPS OR VISORS MAY BE WORN WHILE BOWLING. DRESS AND CASUAL SHORTS ARE PERMITTED. NOT PERMITTED ARE ATHLETIC SHORTS, BASKETBALL SHORTS, WARM-UPS, SWEATS OR SIMILAR TYPES, CUT OFF SHIRTS, SLEEVELESS TANK OR HALTER TOPS, PAINTERS PANTS, SPANDEX, YOGA PANTS, RIPPED JEANS OR CUT OFF SHORTS.**

AVERAGES

- ALL JUNIOR BOWLERS WITH A MINIMUM OF 15 STRINGS IN THE CURRENT SEASON OR WITH AN M.S.C.B.A. AVERAGE WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE. JUNIOR BOWLERS CAN WIN EITHER THE OPEN OR APH AWARD, BUT NOT BOTH IN THE SAME TOURNAMENT. IN THE EVENT OF A BOWLER OR TEAM WINNING BOTH THE OPEN & APH DIVISION, THEY WILL BE AWARDED THE OPEN DIVISION TITLE.
- JUNIOR AVERAGE SYSTEM IS BASED ON THE LAST 25 STRINGS BOWLED IN M.S.C.B.A. EVENTS

SPORTSMANSHIP

1. **SECTION 1.** - ANY PARTICIPANT THAT DAMAGES OR ATTEMPTS TO DAMAGE ANY HOST LANES EQUIPMENT OTHER THAN DURING THE NORMAL AND ACCEPTABLE WAY OF DELIVERING A BOWLING BALL WILL BE IMMEDIATELY REMOVED FROM THE EVENT. SHOULD THIS HAPPEN DURING A TEAMS EVENT, THE REMAINING TEAMMATES MAY CONTINUE TO BOWL AND THE OFFENDING BOWLER WILL BE GIVEN A 0 FROM THAT POINT FORWARD. THE OFFENDING BOWLER WILL BE SUSPENDED FROM THE NEXT M.S.C.B.A. EVENT AND WILL HAVE TO PAY FOR COMPLETE RESTITUTION TO THE HOST LANES.
2. ANY PARTICIPANT WHO IS CONDUCTING THEMSELVES IN A WAY TO DISRUPT OR DELAY THE PROPER ADMINISTRATION OF ANY EVENT SHALL RECEIVE THE SAME PENALTY AS DEFINED IN **SECTION 1.**
3. ANY PARTICIPANT THAT THREATENS ANYONE EITHER VERBALLY OR PHYSICALLY WILL RECEIVE THE SAME PENALTY AS **SECTION 1** AND WILL BE SUSPENDED FOR THE REMAINING M.S.C.B.A. SEASON.
4. ANY BOWLER BEING DISRUPTIVE WHILE BOWLING OR KEEPING SCORE WILL BE WARNED FIRST. IF THE ACTIONS CONTINUE, THE BOWLER WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE PENALTY OF **SECTION 1.** THIS INCLUDES, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, SOCIALLY UNACCEPTABLE LANGUAGE, GESTURES EITHER ON OR OFF THE LANES, CREATING EXCESSIVE NOISE, KICKING/STOMPING, SLAMMING BALLS ON THE RETURN OR OTHER BEHAVIOR DEEMED DISRUPTIVE.

YOUTH SCHOLARSHIPS

1. THE M.S.C.B.A. HAS A SCHOLARSHIP FUND FOR THE BOY & GIRL WITH THE HIGHEST ALL EVENTS SCRATCH PINFALL TOTAL. THE WINNING BOY & GIRL WILL EACH BE AWARDED A \$500 SCHOLARSHIP TO BE USED FOR THEIR POST-HIGH SCHOOL CONTINUING EDUCATION. IN THE EVENT OF A TIE, THOSE YOUTHS WILL EQUALLY SHARE THE \$500. FUNDS WILL ONLY BE DISTRIBUTED ONCE THE YOUTH HAS ENTERED POST HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION AS A REIMBURSEMENT FOR BOOKS, SUPPLIES OR TUITION. IF A YOUTH DOES NOT ENTER INTO POST HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION, HE OR SHE WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE THE FUNDS AFTER REACHING THEIR 25TH BIRTHDAY.
