Green Debris Pick-up!

Save the date: Monday, April 27, 2020

Vuemont HOA is sponsoring a Green Debris Pick-up Day. It's simple to participate, just place your greens waste on the curb by 8 am for pick-up!

This is intended for larger cuttings; place smaller pieces in your greens bins for usual pick-up. Make sure pieces are less than 8 feet in length. No bags please, and definitely no plastic or trash.

Yard Maintenance Reminders...

View Preservation

Our CC&Rs require trees and bushes to be trimmed so they do not interfere with neighbors' views of the Cascade Mountains or Lake Sammamish. In many instances trees and hedges must be **6 feet** or shorter. Check out the CC&Rs for details.

Sidewalk Clearance

The City of Bellevue requires residents to:

- Prune vegetation back 1 foot from the sidewalk edge.
- Prune trees to allow a seven foot vertical clearance.

Invasive Species

English Ivy and Himalayan Blackberry are prevalent in Vuemont. CC&Rs require us to prevent weeds from becoming "a detriment to the subdivision". We ask that everyone help curb the spread, especially to neighbor's yards or to natural green spaces.

King County's website provides information on how to control English Ivy, blackberries, and other weeds.

Remember: Dumping green waste in the green belts is prohibited. It is also illegal to trim or remove trees in the green belt without authorization from the city.
