



What the census is
The census is a survey that happens every 10 years. It gives us a picture of all the people and families in the United States and Wales. The information is used to help local authorities plan for the future.
You have to take part in the census. It's free and it's confidential.

Every two years, our community conducts an official census to ensure that our records remain accurate, up to date, and fully compliant with our governing documents.

Your participation is **required** to help the Board and management team fulfill these responsibilities. Accurate census data ensures we remain compliant with state regulations and community bylaws, while also supporting the smooth and effective operation of our neighborhood.

All residents must complete forms and submit no later than **January 30, 2026**.

We kindly ask all residents to complete and submit the census promptly. Your cooperation ensures we meet our legal obligations and continue maintaining a safe, well-managed, and responsive community.
