The Academy was created in 2021 by the Master Teacher Institute for the Arts to provide an affordable world-class summer music program for high school singers. Current 8th graders through high school seniors are eligible to enroll. All participants will live on the campus of Kansas State University for the duration of the Academy, study with university faculty, and participate in other activities culminating with a choir concert performance on the final day.

We bumped Austria up 4 days to accommodate the ACDA National Music convention in Dallas, TX where many our students could be singing after auditions.

Scholarships

If you're interested in a \$1K or \$2K scholarship, please complete this <u>Scholarship</u> <u>Application</u> by May 1st! Decisions for scholarships will be announced by mid-May.

Cancel for Any-Reason Insurance

If you'd like to purchase the Cancel for Any Reason Insurance through the travel company, you must do so by April 17th! Here is the payment schedule with insurance information, based upon the current number of travelers. You are, of course, welcome to purchase your own travel insurance through whatever company you'd like.

Can I still pay/join?

Yes! If you haven't sent in your payments, it is not too late. However, as soon as the flights are booked, you will have to pay additional costs in the flights beyond our group rate! Send in the \$200 deposit ASAP! If you have not submitted payment, you are not on the roster to attend. Check your email for your updated balance.

We currently have 59 students, 28 adults, and 2 directors traveling to Austria!






MEET MRS. RICHEY-SULLIVAN
