The Santacruz family

Isabel and Alberto with their biological children, daughter-in-law, adopted children and grandchildren. The Santacruz family specializes in eagle hats and other birds of prey. Even with 5 biological children, several years ago this loving family welcomed 4 abandoned children into their home. It's a lot for an artisan family to support.



In Ecuador, the government provides public education, but families must pay for uniforms, registration fees, and educational materials. Arts of Ecuador helps with the educational expenses for their five school age children. Here are the three youngest in their new school uniforms and shoes.

The Ruiz family

José and Lourdes with two of their three adult children, daughter-in-law and grandchildren. All six adults work on hats for Arts of Ecuador. The men do the knitting of the body and other knitted parts of the hats using manually powered knitting machines. The women do the finish work bringing the hats to life.

Since all of our artisans work in their homes, the children have a natural curiosity to see what parents and grandparents are doing.



Traditional skills like transferring yarn from skeins to cones for the knitting machines are taught to children from a young age. But children are encouraged to play, attend school and do their homework.

THE ARTS OF ECUADOR STORY

We are a retired couple, who, in 2013, decided to spend the winter in Ecuador. We discovered this South American nation to be a strikingly diverse and beautiful country with warm, hospitable people. But we also found that good jobs and a reliable income are difficult to come by for most Ecuadorians. We wanted to do something to help. But what?



While visiting local markets, we were attracted to the artistry and quality of the handicrafts we saw. We learned that most items are made in home workshops where artisans often toil 12 to 18 hours a day, seven days a week, just to provide for their family's basic needs. But even with long hours and hard work, there is no guarantee that they will be able to sell their handicrafts for a fair price.

We founded Arts of Ecuador to help these families by purchasing their products at a fair price and marketing them in the United States. We settled on our product line of hand-crafted wool animal hats, Tagua keychains, and colorful coin purses. We work closely with the families to design unique products that will appeal to the American market and, at the same time, provide them with a stable source of income. We also emphasize products and production processes that are environmentally friendly, sustainable and do not adversely impact wildlife habitat.

OUR MAN IN ECUADOR

We could not deliver the quantity or quality of hand-made hats that we do without Fernando, our man in Ecuador. Fernando recruits and trains each artisan to make sure they can produce the quantity of hats requested while meeting all our quality requirements. He also buys the yarn and other supplies like stuffing and lining fabric, estimates what is needed, and distributes it to the families. Finally, he collects all the finished hats, and delivers them to our shipper. Thank you, Fernando, for all you do!



In the years since we started Arts of Ecuador, the company has grown well beyond our initial expectations. Today our unique animal hats and other products in this catalog can be found in hundreds of gift shops across the nation from Alaska to Florida and Maine to California. To all of you, our dealers, representatives, clients and customers, we and the artisan families who lovingly make these wonderful gift items, extend our heartfelt thanks.

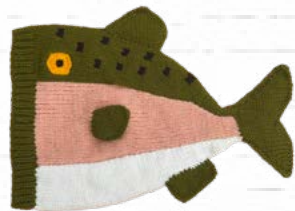

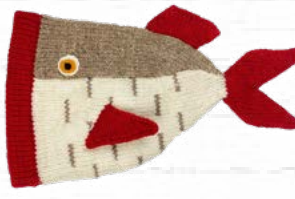

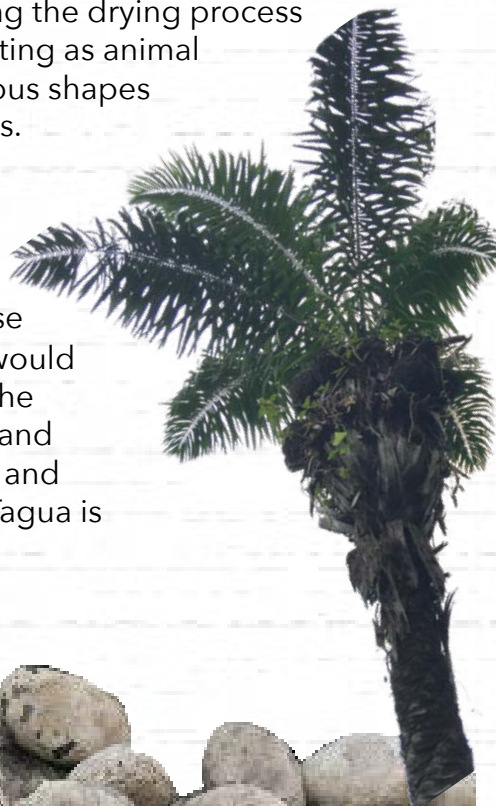
WHAT IS TAGUA?



Tagua, also called vegetable ivory, is a type of coconut that comes from the Tagua Palm tree. The coconut milk in the Tagua seeds solidifies during the drying process becoming as hard and long-lasting as animal ivory. It can be carved into various shapes to produce a variety of products.

Every year each Tagua tree produces bushels of pods containing Tagua nuts. Harvesting and processing these

nuts provides employment for many families that otherwise would have no source of income. In addition, Tagua contributes to the preservation of the rain forest because natives no longer cut and clear the rain forest for fields. Instead, they care for the forest and Tagua trees that provide their only source of income. Today Tagua is often used as a replacement for elephant ivory.
