Services

Business English for individuals (B2C)

- for students aged 18+
- for students B2 level or above

- focusing on business related deliverables; reports, presentations, conference calls

Business English for groups (B2B)

- based on the principles of the above course but designed specifically to meet the requirements of the client

Exam Preparation (IELTS)

- Academic or General IELTS preparation
- material designed to teach exam techniques
- mock speaking exams and past papers to give exam practice

Exam Preparation (Cambridge Exams)

- C2 (formerly CPE), C1 (formerly CAE), B2 (formerly FCE), B1 (formerly PET)
- material designed to teach exam techniques
- mock speaking exams and past papers to give exam practice

General English for individuals

- Offered at all levels of the CEFR from A1-C2 but focusing on B1+
- Resources from well-regarded textbooks, e.g. Outcomes, English File etc. and from internet sources and authentic material.

General English for School Groups

- based on the principles of the above course but tailored to suit the needs of the school, class sizes may be up to 12

Private Tutoring

- Students will be encouraged to bring their own material to the lessons where relevant, e.g. self-study material, written work etc.
- Tutors provide feedback on speaking and writing and advice on what to study and how to improve English skills.
