

### High School A la Carte Options:

**Here are the available a la carte options for high school students for the fall 2018 school year. We have VERY limited spots available in classes and will register students on a first come, first served basis.**

**Tuesday and Thursday** bring your own curriculum and work at CHR with a teacher available to assist as needed. This is a great option for those homeschool students who want the social time, want or need accountability, want or need the ability to ask an in person teacher for help when needed, and want to get out and be with other teens . \$255/month or \$1250/ semester. **9:00am-4:00pm Monday and Wednesday (come and stay as little or as long as desired in this time frame).**

**Monday and Wednesday** bring your own curriculum and work at CHR with a teacher available to assist as needed. This is a great option for those homeschool students who want the social time, want or need accountability, want or need the ability to ask an in person teacher for help when needed, and want to get out and be with other teens . \$255/month or \$1250/ semester. **9:00am-4:00pm Monday and Wednesday (come and stay as little or as long as desired in this time frame).**

**Bring your own curriculum one day a week instead of 2:** This is a great option for those homeschool students who want the social time, want or need accountability, want or need the ability to ask an in person teacher for help when needed, and want to get out and be with other teens . \$255/month or \$1250/ semester. **9:00am-4:00pm (come and stay as little or as long as desired during this time frame)** . \$205/month or \$1000/semester.

**Friday math lab-** bring your own curriculum and come for help as needed. **Fridays 9am-11am.** \$105/month or \$500/semester. This may be taken both semesters. Come for the whole time or just to ask a question or two. Open door math lab.

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**Personal Finance (Dave Ramsey) 9:00am-9:50am Mondays** This semester long course will follow the Dave Ramsey Foundations of Personal Finance curriculum. \$250/semester or \$55/month for the 5 month semester. Supply fee \$50

**AP Lit/Comp 9:00am-9:50am Monday and Wednesday.** \$105/month payment plan for 10 months or \$1000/ year. (AP test is optional and is an additional fee to the AP testing company). This is a year long course. Supply fee \$75

**Algebra 1 9:00am-9:50am Monday and Wednesday.** Optional (come when you want) math lab small group tutoring meets **Friday 9:00am-11:00am** is included in tuition. This is a year long course. \$130/ month for the payment plan in the 10 month school year or \$1250/year Supply fee \$75

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**Geometry 10:00am-10:50am Monday and Wednesday.** Optional (come when you want)math lab small group tutoring meets **Friday 9:00am-11:00am** is included in tuition. This is a year long course. \$130/ month for the payment plan in the 10 month school year or \$1250/year. Supply fee \$75

**Algebra 2 10:00am-10:50am Monday and Wednesday.** Optional (come when you want)math lab small group tutoring meets **Friday 9:00am-11:00am** is included in tuition. This is a year long course. \$130/ month for the payment plan in the 10 month school year or \$1250/year. Supply fee \$75

**9<sup>th</sup> grade Lit/Comp 10:00am-10:50am Monday and Wednesday.** This year long class will focus on writing skills, literature, and grammar lessons. Tuition is \$1000/ year or \$105/month for the 10 month payment plan. Supply fee: \$75

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**American Lit/Comp 11:00am-11:50am Monday and Wednesday.** This year long class will focus on writing skills, literature, and grammar lessons. Tuition is \$1000/ year or \$105/month for the 10 month payment plan. Supply fee: \$75

**Math lab ALEKS -any level 11:00am-11:50am Monday and Wednesday.** Optional (come when you want)math lab small group tutoring meets **Friday 9:00am-11:00am** is included in tuition. This is a year long course. \$130/ month for the payment plan in the 10 month school year or \$1250/year. Supply fee \$75

**Pre-Calculus 11:00am-11:50am Monday and Wednesday.** Optional (come when you want) math lab small group tutoring meets **Friday 9:00am-11:00am** is included in tuition. \$130/ month for the payment plan in the 10 month school year or \$1250/year by July 25. Supply fee \$75

**Art History/ Art lab** Art History meets on Monday and Art meets on Wednesday. **Monday and Wednesday 11:00am-11:50am.** The history lessons correlate to the art projects. Take one or both of these semester long courses. Individual tuition is \$250/semester or \$55/month for 5 months. Both classes are \$500/semester or \$55/month for 5 months. Supply fee individually \$50, for both \$75.

**Forensic Science Monday 1:00pm-1:50pm** - This is a flipped class and students are expected to come to class prepared for labs and discussions. This one semester high school class will provide an introduction to Forensic Science and Criminal Justice law. We will study the history of Forensics, learn about the various specialty areas of a forensic laboratory, and examine the responsibilities and duties of a Forensic Scientist. Our case studies, activities, and labs will involve deductive and inductive reasoning, fingerprinting, Forensic Psychiatry, Forensic Engineering, and Forensic Odontology. \$250/semester or \$55/month for the 5 month semester. Supply fee \$50

**Biology with Lab Monday and Wednesday 1:00pm-1:50pm** Controversial subjects such as the age of the earth, evolution vs creationism, etc will be brought up in this class. Parents will be notified prior to these topics occurring in lessons in the syllabus but if one comes up unexpectedly in discussion, it will be briefly discussed in a non-biased way stating there are many beliefs and opinions and this class is not where are debating them. All students are welcome at CHR. Supply fee \$75

**Ted Talks Club Mondays 1:00pm-1:50pm** . This class is free HOWEVER, students must be enrolled in hybrid or at least 1 other course to enroll. This class is about exploring exciting new ideas involving Technology, Entertainment, and Design. We will watch, discuss, and evaluate the most highly rated, informative TED Talks. Using the TED speakers' guide, we will write and perform our own short, highly entertaining and informative talks. This class exposes students to new ideas, and teaches students to critically evaluate what they hear and see. Students will greatly improve their own personal communication skills while practicing immitating very effective public speakers.

**Health Wednesday 1:00pm-1:50pm** This one semester course covers the requirements for high school health. Human body, healthy habits, psychological factors to health, and drugs/alcohol/unsafe choices are covered. Tuition \$250/semester or \$60/month for the 5 month payment plan. \$250/semester or \$55/month for the 5 month semester. Supply fee \$50

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**ASL 1 (American Sign Language) Monday and Wednesday 2:00pm-2:50pm** This year long American Sign language course covers the first year language concepts as well as deaf culture. Tuition is \$1000/year or \$105/month for the monthly payment plan for 10 months. Supply fee \$50.

**Spanish 1 Monday and Wednesday 2:00pm-2:50pm** Spanish 1 and 2 are combined together in this year long course. Tuition is \$1000/year or \$105/month for the monthly payment plan for 10 months. Supply fee \$75

**Spanish 2 Monday and Wednesday 2:00pm-2:50pm** Spanish 1 and 2 are combined together in this year long course. Tuition is \$1000/year or \$105/month for the monthly payment plan for 10 months. Supply fee \$75

**US History Monday and Wednesday 2:00pm-2:50pm** This year long U.S. History course examines our nation's history from colonial times up to the present. We will use engaging discussions, activities, media, and the BJU United States History textbook to learn about Columbus to the 2000 election. . Tuition is \$1000/year or \$105/month for the monthly payment plan for 10 months. Supply fee \$75

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**ASL 2 Monday and Wednesday 3:00pm-3:50pm** This year long American Sign language course covers the second and third year language concepts as well as deaf culture in a combined course. Tuition is \$1000/year or \$105/month for the monthly payment plan for 10 months. Supply fee \$50

**ASL 3 Monday and Wednesday 3:00pm-3:50pm** This year long American Sign language course covers the second and third year language concepts as well as deaf culture in a combined course. Tuition is \$1000/year or \$105/month for the monthly payment plan for 10 months. Supply fee \$50

**Government Monday 3:00pm-3:50pm** This semester long course satisfies the Government requirement for high school students. \$250/semester or \$55/month for the 5 month semester. Supply fee \$50.

**Study Skills Wednesday 3:00pm-3:50pm** This class, taken for one or two semesters, will help support students in their general academic success. We begin by examining, choosing, and setting up personal organizational systems and learning to fully utilize Edsby, our school's Learning Management System. Then we will practice test taking skills and learn more about Latin and Greek word meanings to increase our vocabulary. Approximately half of the class will be devoted to study skills, and the remaining half will be used towards supporting other classes that students may need aid or guidance concerning. \$250/semester or \$55/month for the 5 month semester. Supply fee \$50

**Student Government** : **Monday 3:00pm-3:50pm** Our student council members will work on cultivating their leadership and teamwork skills, support our school and their fellow students, serve our community, and help enhance our positive school climate. Students will share their ideas, wants, interests, and concerns with our teachers and administration. They will help to plan and orchestrate class specific and school-wide events and community projects to help others. This class may be taken for one or both semesters. This class has special guidelines for enrollment. Please contact us to enroll.

**Yearbook**: **Wednesday 3:00pm-3:50pm** In Yearbook Staff class, students will learn to take high quality pictures, edit pictures and pages, generate creative ideas, and then follow through each detail to make their ideas a reality throughout the pages of our 2018-2019 yearbook. Our goal will be to create a very high quality yearbook that we can all be proud of and features EVERY student in our school.
