<u>9am-12noon Tuesday and Thursday:</u> Students may enroll in the <u>language arts and math BLOCK</u> that occurs during this 3 hour period. This is a part of the hybrid program and VERY limited spaces are available. Homework and assessments will be given, and these classes are separated by grade level as follows: k,1,2,3,4-5combo class. Please note that if you are enrolling in these blocks <u>and</u> electives, it is probably cheaper to do hybrid. The supply fee is \$200 for the year and the tuition is separate from electives stated below. The tuition for this block comes out to \$250/month on a yearlong contract.

1230-130 Tuesday and Thursday: Students may enroll in the social studies and science BLOCK that occurs during this hour. This is a part of the hybrid program and very limited spaces are available. Some teachers do one day of each subject each week, and others do one unit in each subject and then switch to the other subject. Homework and assessments will be given and science is lab based. The students will be placed in grade level classes as follow: k,1,2,3,4-5 combo. Tuition for this block comes out to \$125/month on a yearlong contract. The supply fees are \$150 for the year and include everything needed for science labs and hands on activities.

Lunch is from 12-1230 each day for elementary students.

130pm Tuesday

K-2 Art (Kristine) Children will be drawing, coloring, cutting, pasting, crafting and creating a variety of lovelies for your refrigerator. We will draw our inspiration from nature, holidays, cultures, other artists and our experiences, while we learn to interpret, critique and communicate about art. We'll be learning about primary and secondary colors while we color, blend and shade with crayons, colored pencils, markers, pastels and paints.
