Writing for Success Workshop: This class meets from 10am-12noon Monday through Thursday for 1 week. Students may enroll in multiple sessions to improve SAT/ACT writing scores or to just better develop their writing for high school, college courses. This is a non-credit bearing course and is open to all students from public, private, and homeschool environments. The fee is \$150/student/session. Session options are

June 17-20

July 8-11

July 15-18

Electives, Credit Recovery, and Summer classes: Students may take regular (non science lab) semester long courses this summer between June 3 and July 25. We would be happy to discuss with students and parents individually to determine which are best for students. We have a long list of options for elective and credit recovery. Courses will be double speed and will require great effort by the student. Students will be assigned work and they have two options.

OPTION 1: They may take each course as an independent study course, completing it at home on their own contacting the instructor via Edsby when needed for \$100/course. ALL work MUST be turned in by noon on July 25 for grading and credit. Only extreme circumstances will grant exceptions on this deadline.

OPTION 2: Students may take courses at CHR with the help of a certified teacher or assistant. Students may come to CHR on Tuesday and Thursday every week or as needed to complete the work necessary to be successful between June 3 and July 18. Small groups and individual tutoring will be included during the hours of 9am-12noon each day. The tuition for this is \$250/course. A minimum and maximum number of participants is required so please register early.

These are great classes for homeschool students, whether accredited or not, as well as academy/private school students. If you are coming from another school to join us this summer, please contact us to ensure your school gives the credit earned to you prior to enrolling.

Liability/Medical Release

In consideration of my child being allowed to participate in the classes and/or activities, camps, and events at CHR or a separate location outsourced by CHR and activities provided by and or sponsored by Canton Homeschool Resources and all teachers,

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volunteers, and individuals associated with CHR, I assume all risk, including any risks associated with any special medical needs or condition of myself, family members, guests, of mine and my child, of our/my child's participation in any such activities, including travel incident thereto. I certify that I have insurance reasonably sufficient to cover my child against injury and loss of life caused to my child or caused by my child in connection with such participation and I agree that all expenses relating to or arising out of any such injuries or loss of life will be my sole financial responsibility and my child and I agree to release and hold harmless and indemnify, Canton Homeschool Resources, and all teachers, volunteers, and individuals associated with CHR from and against any and all liability for ANY harm, injury damage, claims, demands, actions, causes of actions or cost and expenses of ANY nature for which my child, my child's family, estate, heirs, administrators, representatives and assigns, arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including but not limited to suffering, pain, disability and severe injury (including death), that may be sustained by my child in conjunction with my child's participation in the classes and activities. I am solely responsible for anything that could happen and hold CHR and all affiliates harmless and not responsible. I understand and agree to these terms.

By enrolling at CHR or by attending any event or activity sponsored at or by the organization, including but not limited to classes, athletic events, dances, and field trips, you have released CHR from all liability and take responsibility for all injuries and accidents that may occur en route, on site, or at any of our events. You also agree to release CHR and any of its employees and contracted workers from any liability in relation to any school related activities/events or arranged transportation of children. You are also agreeing to several policies when you enrolled stated written and in verbal form and have released all agents from all liabilities in any form. CHR is not responsible for any student belongings. Should ANY dispute ever arise that should be taken to a legal level, this agreement ensures that mediation will be attempted avoiding an expensive jury trial and attorneys. By being a part of the CHR organization, you agree to this policy and waive your rights to pursue legal action outside of a mediation environment. This is beneficial for both parties as a third party, without the high costs of court, can make a legal decision.

In the event of an emergency, or perceived emergency, I understand that CHR will call 911 first and the parent second. I release CHR and its associates from all fees and repercussions that may occur from emergency services. I give CHR permission to treat and to have my child treated if medically deemed appropriate by CHR or emergency personnel. I hold all individuals attempting to assist my child harmless.

Students must be picked up on time. Those not picked up within 10 minutes of the agreed upon time will be placed in the aftercare program and the parent is responsible and is

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agreeing to pay these fees. They are not pro-rated and will be charged in whole for partial use of any amount.

SIGNATURE

Students are allowed to bring technology devices to CHR. As the parent, we encourage you to talk with your student about appropriate websites, cyber etiquette, and safety. While we try to monitor usage, students do have breaks when they like to bring out their devices. We cannot monitor every student closely enough to determine that every second is spent on an appropriate website. CHR, and its affiliates, are not to be held responsible for website activity outside what we instruct the students to use. We encourage you, as parents, to download apps to prevent your child from visiting adult sites if they wish to bring their devices to CHR. Teachers can and often will require students to NOT have their devices out during the day. It is at the discretion of the teacher and administration when devices can be used at CHR. Cyber bullying is immediate cause for dismissal at the sole discretion of CHR.

Please sign below acknowledging a release of liability for the actual device if it is lost or stolen when brought to CHR; a release of liability for all content viewed on technology that was not assigned to students; and that you have spent time watching the videos and exploring the above listed website or one similar.
