Competition dancers attend regular dance classes, competition group classes, 3 competitions, a dance convention, dance recitals, and additional performances. All dancers wishing to participate in competition groups and their parents need to read the competition requirements for 2019-20 and sign up at the front desk prior to attending placement classes.

*2018/19 Starburst, Flash, Glitz, Mystique, Radiance, Exhilaration, Spice, Shock, Tip Tap Toe & TapTastic members of any age should attend the 13 & up placement only.

What To Wear

Jazz, Lyrical and Gymnastics—Any color leotard and tights and applicable dance shoes. Hairbun or ponytail, no bangs in eyes, please. 13+ dancers, please bring t-straps. All ages bring ballet slippers.

Tap—Any dancewear and your favorite tap shoe. No bangs in eyes, please.

Hip Hop—Something that makes you feel "hip" and your favorite hip hop sneaker, (clean) street shoe or boot.

- -Placement classes are optional for dancers ages 7 and under.
- -Please come to your appropriate age and level unless your 2018/19 group is noted above.
- -Dancers may arrive 30 min. prior to any placement class to quietly "warm-up".
- -Some dancers may receive a "call back" to audition with an older/more advanced group. Keep this in mind as it might make for a long day. Please bring plenty of water, healthy snacks and something to read or otherwise occupy your time.
- -Dancers who are planning to stay in the waiting area while other placement classes are being conducted will be expected to sit quietly so as not cause distraction. Disruptive dancers will be asked to call a parent to be picked up.
