

Specialty Work Showcase

We're excited to bring back our **Specialty Work Showcase** at Debbi's Dance, Etc., pending enough interest.

This fun event is a wonderful way to spark and showcase your dancer's emerging choreography skills, as well as give dancers the opportunity to perform their **solo, duo, and trio work on stage**. It also provides the chance for **six routines** to be featured in our **50th Anniversary Dance Spectacular** at the **Washington Center for the Performing Arts** in June.

Spring Break is a wonderful time to begin working on student choreography pieces. We are also introducing **Student Choreography Skills in Company Class**, helping dancers explore creativity, musicality, and leadership as they develop their own work. Exploring choreography is such a meaningful part of growing as a dancer, and we're excited to support them in this process.

We are currently working on securing a location for the event. Our **first-choice date** is the weekend of **May 16–17** (the same weekend as the Lacey Spring Fun Fair performance). Our **backup date**, pending venue availability, is **Saturday, June 6**.

The **entry deadline is Tuesday, March 25, 2026**. If there is not enough interest to move forward with the event, all entry fees will be **credited to your dance account**.

Dance Spectacular Performance Opportunity

A total of **six routines** will be selected to perform in one of the **Debbi's Dance, Etc. Dance Spectacular** shows at the **Washington Center for the Performing Arts, June 20–21**:

- **Three Student Choreography pieces**
- **Three "People's Choice" winners**

How Winners Are Chosen

People's Choice will be determined by ballot at the showcase. Each ticket holder will receive **one ballot** to vote for their favorite **solo, duo, or trio**. Please note that **Student Choreography entries are not eligible for People's Choice**.

All **Student Choreography** entries will receive **judges' feedback**, and the **top three scoring routines** will be selected to perform in our **Dance Spectacular Recital**.

Routine Time Limits: Student Choreography: 2 min 30 sec. People's Choice: 2 min 45 sec.
