**WISTA** is an international association for women at senior levels in the shipping and trade sector, with branches in more than 55 countries around the world. **WISTA** provides networking and educational opportunities for the women participants in this sector.

For **WISTA** New Zealand, accomplishing the key objectives of the association includes advancing the industry as a whole. To this end we are committed to promoting New Zealand shipping and trade through the promotion of women in the sector within New Zealand.

**WISTA NZ** is an inclusive organisation and most events are open to non-members, both men and women. **WISTA NZ** operates chapters in Auckland, Tauranga, Wellington and Christchurch.

### Who makes up the Membership of WISTA NZ?

**WISTA NZ** welcomes women in roles within shipping and trade at all levels of the industry. In addition to private membership, **WISTA** also offers a Corporate Membership. Since the New Zealand branch of **WISTA** was incorporated in **March 2014**, it has attracted more than 285 current members, including 40 Corporate memberships.


## Support WISTA NZ through Event or Annual Corporate sponsorship

## Benefits of Annual Membership - Corporate

Additionally, **WISTA NZ** offers companies a Corporate Membership option. In addition to all of the benefits mentioned in the previous section for the individuals, our corporate membership also offers:

- giving you flexibility to tailor your staff attendance according to the event and staff availability.
- you may change registered female members throughout the membership year as required without any penalty
- opportunities to enhance and promote business objectives
- ability to raise the profile of your own organisation
- offers new contacts and opportunities for your business by providing a network that is complementary to traditional shipping and trade networks
- ability to recognise those women within your organisation who may be progressing to leadership roles through promotion at global events run by WISTA and lastly
- an opportunity for your organisation to demonstrate industry leadership in developing women's careers and strengthening your workforce diversity
- opportunity to participate in and explore business synergies by attending the global WISTA conference run each year

The networking and education opportunities that **WISTA NZ** promotes will also provide women employees and executives with a greater depth of understanding of the international context in which we work in New Zealand in shipping and trade. To this end our events are open to the business colleagues of women in our membership including their peers and seniors, male or female.

Corporate memberships will be allocated to a WISTA region. Corporates may take out multiple regional memberships. Auckland domiciled memberships are available in minimum blocks of 5, Tauranga, Wellington and Christchurch in minimum blocks of 3. If a corporate has multiple regional memberships, staff from anywhere in NZ may attend an event free of charge, providing the total number per event does not exceed the regional membership number. Staff attendance in excess of those numbers will receive a 50% discount off the door fee. Corporates who only have one regional membership are still welcome to attend events outside their region – and also will receive a 50% discount off the door fee.
