DIRECTIONS

Our event is held at Livestock Barn #1 adjacent to the restrooms. You can either enter on Blue Bell Road in front of the fairground offices and swing around to the back or enter Gate 24 from Independence Street.

Full RV hook-ups with water, electric and sewer (\$30/night) is along the chain-link fence past the Rodeo Arena. Around 10 hook-ups with electric are available adjacent to Livestock Barn #1 (\$20/night). RV camping is on a first come, first served basis. The fairgrounds folks require us to collect the funds and provide a pass. After you check-in, you may see what camping is available; then return to receive your “camping” sticker at our registration desk.

Goats may arrive any time after 9 AM on Thursday, May 4th. All goats must be checked in and measured by Saturday, May 6th 8:00 AM. Each animal to be exhibited will be checked in and measured by the Measuring Committee.

ENTRY & PEN FEES

Entry fee is \$80 per goat for all 8 shows.

No entry fee for more than 10 goats

Free entry for Wethers

The pen fee is \$18 per pen, \$10 per tack pen (no bedding). Fee includes set-up, pine shavings, as well as, bedding removal after the show. There are 196 show pens, 6 x 6 with concrete floor, welded frame and wire mesh dividers. There are plenty of wash stations.

NOTE: You must provide your own hay.

Deadline for SHOW ENTRY FORMS is April 28th.

Copies of MSFGA Registration Certificates must accompany all show entries.

Any entries submitted after May 3rd will be accepted but not be published in the show program.

PLEASE DO NOT send your entry forms via MESSENGER or TEXT. Either email your entries or use the US Postal Service.

There will be no refunds for any reason.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Any goat exhibiting signs of infectious disease or symptoms of illness will not be permitted on the show grounds. This determination will be at the discretion of the show superintendent. Registered goats with a registration tattoo number accompanied by registration papers and a Scrapie Eradication Program premise ID number do not require a Scrapie ear tag. Intrastate goats must have a registration certificate, a registration tattoo number and a Scrapie Premise ID number. SHOW RULES

Miniature Silky Fainting Goat Association rules shall govern this show. Refer to the MSFGA website www.msfgaregistry.org for complete show rules. All goats entered in the shows must be registered with the MSFGA. Over height animals will not be permitted to compete in the shows. Does must not exceed 23.5” at the withers and bucks must not exceed 25” at the withers. All animals will be measured by an official measurement committee.

AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded through fourth place in all regular classes. Rosettes will be presented to Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion and Best Wether in Show winners. Rosettes and special trophies will be presented to Best in Show winners.

RAFFLE

There will be a raffle following the last two shows on Saturday. Tickets will be 15 tickets for \$20 or 6 tickets for \$10. If you would like to donate an item in the raffle, please let Susan French know so that all items can be identified on the raffle table with your farm name.

Complementary beverages will be provided on show days and lunch will be provided on Saturday.
