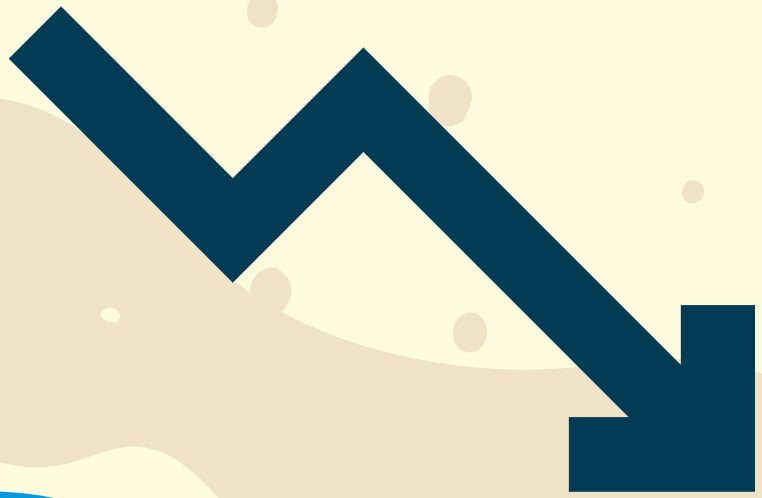


4Rs
