## Information about eggs

Barn eggs laid by hens temporarily housed in barns for their welfare

All free range hens in the UK are temporarily being kept indoors on Government veterinary advise, to keep them safe from avian influenza.

This means that free range egg packs, and food products made with free range eggs, may currently contain barn eggs, from hens housed in barns for the short term.

Where packs contain barn eggs, the eggs will be marked with a number 2, for example 2UK54321.
