as humans. Food binds us. There was a joke I saw recently when children where asked, "What is marriage?" One of the responses was, "Marriage is two people asking each other what they want to eat and then they die."

In our congregation we have been blessed. We have a group of members who have been a part of this congregation for a long time. Our legacy members have a rich history and tradition with this congregation. They know people and they know how things work.

We have also been blessed, since COVID, to have received into our community of faith a great number of newer members to our community. These new members are exciting and energetic for the ministry that Grace has to offer. What a blessing!

As I look around our congregation, I see that many of our legacy members and many of our new members do not really know each other. As the pastor I began to ask the question, how do we bring these people together? Food!

Tables of Eight was a mission our congregation had when I first got here. Eight people gathered together around a table to share a meal and get to know each other better. When I came here as a new pastor this was a great way for me to get to know people.

We are resurrecting this program as a way to build more community in our congregation. From January 2026 to May 2026, we are hoping to have three meals within these groups. In order to do that we are looking for people to host these events.

Hosting events may sound daunting. No, you do not have to make dinner for all eight people. No, you do not have to hunt and gather for all to be the perfect host. Some groups might want to do a full dinner. Some groups might want to just do appetizers. Some groups may also only want to do dessert. It is totally up to the groups what they want to do. The hosts would simply serve as communication for all the members of the group and with the pastor. They would also assist in the planning, while allowing their entire group to help execute the evening.

In the book of Joshua God constantly remind Joshua to be strong and courageous. I am hoping that some will call on their strength to

step out of their comfort zone and be willing to be a host. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to let me know. Enjoy the holidays. Enjoy the meals. Most of all, enjoy the company.
