# A Message from the Pastor

What is a Sabbatical?

Genesis 2:2 reads, "By the seventh day God completed the work which had been done, and God rested on the seventh day from all the work that had been done." This is the biblical injunction and the establishment of the Sabbath. Sabbath literally means "to rest." Rest is so important to all conscious beings that God made it a commandment.

A Sabbatical is a time of rest. In the biblical command of the Sabbath Day it was God's intention that one should stop their normal work and focus on their faith, family, and give their bodies a chance to rest. All too often we humans do not take seriously the biblical command to rest. We fill our off time with activities and travel and seldom just take the time to sit.

At the Annual Meeting a couple of weeks ago it was announced that the Congregational Council had approved a Sabbatical for me as pastor. This means that I will be taking time away from pastoral responsibilities for the months of May, June, and July. This will be a time of not only rest and rejuvenation, but it will also be a time of professional development.

Pastors live a very different kind of life. And I admit that I have not been faithful in my own sabbath time. Moving from a global pandemic to a renovation project, unfortunately, pressed me a bit physically and mentally. A time of Sabbath is needed for me to rest and rejuvenate myself for ministry.

In light of this our congregation has blessed me with the gift of time. During this time I will be focusing on three areas of development and learning. These areas will help to strengthen my own life as well as the life of the congregation. With about a decade of ministry left before I am eligible to retire I do not want to just coast into retirement. I want my last years of ministry to be meaningful and full of purpose.

These three areas of focus will be in mindfulness, meditation, and trauma recovery.

In the next couple of newsletters I will share with you why I chose these three areas and what it is I hope to accomplish by studying them. I am excited about this opportunity.

Thank you all for being patient and supportive in this endeavor. Not only will I be able to learn new skills to better minister to this congregation, but it will also allow the congregation to learn more about itself and find strengths it may have not even known it had. This time of Sabbatical will be a blessing when we place our trust in God.
